CAC's annual business meeting was held. The pastor's report gave many details of all that was accomplished in the last year, and on the church's encouraging state. Thanks to the wonderful faithfulness of all the members, the church's financial posture is solid. We anticipate that if the Lord tarries, we will be having a mortgage burning ceremony by Easter of 2008! Two helpful resolutions were discussed and carried. The first resolution legally establishes the fact that CAC's Membership Covenant is in fact enjoined by all CAC members, and that each member affirms his or her commitment to the covenant by their participation as a member of CAC. Essentially, one cannot both claim to be a member, and yet also claim that the Membership Covenant and By-Laws due not apply to them. The second resolution establishes a more efficient method of conducting elections, while also giving church members even more input in the choosing of officers. Several offices were filled on the nominating ballot because of some members receiving more than two-thirds of the vote for those certain offices. The remaining elections will be held in continuing business set to convene this coming Wednesday, March 7.
