Last Sunday...

CAC's "Launch" Youth Revival reached its climactic conclusion. Pascal Crites, Youth President for the WV District, was our special guest and a main speaker for the event. He preached a powerful message based on the life of Saul, an Old Testament king of Israel. Even though Saul was called and chosen of God and had His anointing, Saul was not infallible. At the end of Saul's sad series of rebellious decisions and unlawful commands, his own armor bearer finally refused Saul's last order, for the servant to slay his own master. In deep despair, Saul then took his own life with his own sword.

How the mighty are fallen! Brother Crites illustrated powerfully how Saul's natural demise was preceded spiritual suicide, and preached that we all must be careful so that we do not fall prey to the enemy through making similar bad choices: Don't disobey godly spiritual authority or ignore the man of God in your life; Don't disobey God's word or choose your own plan over God's plan for your life. In his bitter end, Saul was comfortable with hiding his kingship behind a disguise. May God help us not ever be comfortable in a worldly disguise. After the meeting was a fellowship dinner & activities.

Last Wednesday...

Pastor Joseph preached "Brotherhood in Crisis" using 1 John 2:7-14 as his main text. The biblical standard of self-sacrifice for both of our brotherhoods (both that of the First Adam and that of the Second Adam) is a mark of perfection in maturity. Biblically, we are to be perfect in this, even as the Lord is. 1 John 3:15 tells us that if any man hate his brother, he is a murderer and has "no eternal life abiding in him." Jesus laid down his life for us, so ought we to be willing to lay down our lives for the brethren. We must show forth the love of God. In Matthew 5:38-48, Jesus taught on love and against retaliation. We aren't supposed to live on what we have heard, but what saith the Lord. Matthew 5:44 says "Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you" Proverbs teaches us that a soft answer turns away wrath.
