<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Second Breath”—about the breath of God and its power to grant us new life. He read from Genesis of when God formed man from the dust of the earth and then breathed into his nostrils and man became a living soul. God’s “First Breath” into Adam caused life, both natural (physical) life and spiritual life. Adam later snuffed out that life by choosing to sin. All creation was cursed because of Adam’s sin. But God’s “Second Breath” upon mankind (the infilling of the Holy Ghost) undoes damage done by the curse we all inherited from Adam. Some restoration is still pending the Rapture (when we get glorified bodies), but our spirits can be regenerated now, in this life. It is absolutely essential for us to have God’s “Second Breath” of life in us, by being filled with the Holy Ghost. We also considered the biblical account of Ezekiel’s prophetic vision in which a valley of dried bones, when blown upon by the winds from God, got new flesh—muscles, tendons, organs, skin, etc—and came alive to become a mighty army. God gave us “spiritual resuscitation” when He filled us with His Spirit. Now we live on in Him by continually “breathing” in God. Another analogy (besides breathing) is that we continually “drink” God in, because His Spirit is in us (within our innermost being) as a well of living water springing up into everlasting life (John 4:14). Praise God!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Be Careful, Little Lips, What You Say.” When Moses’ father-in-law, Jethro, spoke to Moses, he spoke to him face to face. He gave Moses counsel and told him “The thing that thou doest is not good” (Exodus 18:17). Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses behind his back—gossip—concerning a woman he married, and the Lord was very displeased. The kingdom of God is about teamwork. Each one of us has a position. Our strength may be better in another position. Moses obeyed Jethro’s counsel, and all was well. Miriam and Aaron gossiped about Moses, and Miriam became leprous. If you have a criticism of someone, speak the truth to them in love—face to face. Gossip drives a wedge between people. Gossip is to speak salacious details about someone behind their back. God hates one who sows discord (Proverbs 6:19). If someone tries to gossip to you, shut of the flow of gossip by ending the conversation right away, and then go straight to the victim and let them know what is being said and who said it, so they can make things right. “Confronting” is needed to stop the vicious cycle that is “gossip.”</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Rescue Mission” using Matthew 18:10-14 for the text. God wants us to rejoice when the lost sheep come home. In Jesus’ parable of the prodigal son, the elder brother was upset when the father threw a party because the prodigal came home. But the father to the elder brother, “all that I have is thine.” We need to lay aside all malice, ill will, animosity and guile, and welcome backsliders home. The mandate of the church is to witness unto the lost AND to go after the sheep that have gone astray. Let us who are in the church stay faithful to God. We need to stay strong so when those who have been astray come home, we can welcome them with open arms. God has great mercy on lost sheep that return to Him. Peter asked Jesus how many times we should forgive our brethren. Jesus said “seventy times seven.” In other words, just keep on forgiving—don’t hold the past against them when they repent. Be ready to rejoice with the lost sheep as they come home.</p>
