<p>Pastor Joseph taught “Heavenly Perfume” using II Corinthians 2:14-17, John 12: 1-8 and Ecclesiastes 10:1-2. God has a sense of smell. Wickedness stinks to Him. Doing our best to serve and worship Him is a sweet smell to Him. When we’re filled with the Holy Ghost we gain perception to sense spiritual things. God gave Moses a specific recipe to make a perfume for the tabernacle. God told Moses to put some of the perfume at the entrance of the tent of meeting. God also told Moses to tell the people that they can’t make this perfume for their own homes, because this smell is only for God’s house. Sometimes God puts us through things. But when we go through things with God, and God’s people stand behind us, we come out smelling sweet. We are to bear one another’s burdens. God brings us all together and makes us into perfume. It’s amazing how some people can get what God is saying, and some don’t. Mary set aside very costly perfume for Jesus. She just walked into the room where Jesus was and anointed His feet and dried them with her hair. Judas Iscariot was the opposite of what Jesus wanted. He began irate questioning of why the costly perfume wasn’t sold and the money given to the poor. Some people are negative and complain about everything. That is a stink to God. But when we give our all to God, it is a sweet smell in his nostrils. We are a special perfume, holy unto God—for Him alone!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Prince of Peace” using Isaiah 9:2-7 as his main text. The church of God is an “alive” church. Isa. 9:6 “For unto us a child is given....” That child is the Prince of Peace. He gives peace no matter the situation. He is the calm in the midst of the storm. God did not give us a spirit of fear. We need to make up our mind—Jesus and we are going to get through this. The devil is a liar. He can’t hurt us. No weapon formed against us shall prosper. God will protect His people. Some day we will rule and reign with Him. People who don’t have confidence in the future, fear death. If we believe in Jesus and know that the devil is a liar, we don’t fear death. Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His saints. God’s kingdom never stops increasing. There are angels encamped round about those that fear God. We are going to be changed in the twinkling of an eye. We are in God’s Kingdom. We should not disobey the authority of the kingdom. We need to analyze our heart. Let’s rid our hearts of anything that should not be there. God’s people are a holy people, a peculiar people. We are citizens in His Kingdom of Peace.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Who’s In Charge Here” using Hebrews 1:10-14 and 2:1, 5-9. T.F. Tenney has said, “Success without a successor is a failure.” Leaders often make a grave error in not training a successor. We are to be the successors to the angels. We will one day become judges over angelic beings that were created before us (they are like elder brothers to us). In Jesus’ parable of the prodigal son, the Father told the eldest son, “Everything I have is yours.” Moses appointed Joshua as the new leader after him. Let’s not make a mistake of hanging on to our certain positions too long. Everyone wants to be involved. Don’t feel like, “This is my job, nobody else can have it.” No matter what ministry we fulfill in the church, we should be thinking about who will succeed us. Let’s not make the mistake of not knowing when to change which train we’re on. The angels are all “ministering spirits” who are serving us and trying to train us for their own jobs! We have authority. But be mature. Move on in due time, even as the angels do.</p>
