By contrast, Leah was rather plain, yet her much better qualities were of substance, not just vanity of showy good looks. However, her lack of outer beauty and dearth of love from Jacob caused her to suffer through a complex that she had to grow out of as she matured. Some people sit in the church pews, sing, and clap their hands, yet their hearts are consumed with the “Leah Complex.” Church isn’t for showing off, or having a fashion show, or to compete with one another. We should come to church to praise God. The names of Leah’s first three sons typify spirits that can bother those who suffer from the “Leah Complex.” The first was named Reuben, which means “afflicted.” Affliction affects us all. If we stay afflicted, it only gets worse. The second son she called Simeon, which infers “cry baby.” We ought to cry out to God, not weep in a pity party. The Lord has the answers to any problem we have. If God brings you to it, He will take you through it! The third son she named Levi, which means “attached.” We are often haunted by things that happened in the past. Spirits can attach to us. We need to get rid of them. We can crush the eggs of the serpent, crush the serpent’s head, and we can also shake the attached serpent loose! Eventually, her fourth son she named Judah, referring to celebration! The church is not barren. We love to celebrate our freedom in God. <b>We praise God that on Thursday night, Madison Colombo and the Godwin’s niece, Olivia Fox, received the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Also, on Sunday night, Eric McClain and Kiana Devericks received the baptism of the Holy Ghost, and Kiana was water baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ! Praise the Lord!</b></p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “You’re Told On!” using I Samuel 8:1-6, 19-21 as his text. Samuel was a precious leader; he was the last judge. Yet God did not make Samuel’s sons judges. <i>Samuel did.</i> When God makes the call, it’s right. But disaster can occur when a preacher “gets” family members voted in. His sons walked not in his ways. They turned aside after bribes and corrupted judgment. Then the people rose up and demanded a king over them so that they could be like the other nations. They were a rebellious people. God told Samuel that the people were not rejecting him but God Himself. God does not want His people to be like everyone else. We are to be a peculiar people – act, walk, talk, dress different from the world. Yet the people chose to sin. They did what they wanted to do. And sin brings forth death. Be careful what you desire! God said He would give us the desires of our heart.</p>
