<p>Elder Lorren Godwin taught on Church Government. Each person has a very important role in the church. “And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues” (I Corinthians 12:28). If prophets are not one hundred percent correct, they aren’t listening to God. Submit yourselves to God. When we’re out and throw a fit, we aren’t submitting to God. Pastors carry a heavy responsibility. They must give account for each soul under them. So we need to obey those who have rule over us. The pastor has responsibility to care for his church. When we (as sheep) go astray, the pastor (as shepherd) must find us. The pastor must willingly feed the flock. The pastor should appoint elders. Bishops should be blameless, just and pure. The pastor provides vision for the church. The saddest thing is when we have no pastor. The church gets confused. Pastors, elders and leaders push us to pray and worship. They are responsible to lead us. Psalms 133:1 “Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!” When we dwell together in unity, not stirring up gossip and trouble, is when God’s anointing comes. We need to work together as one. We praise God for the wonderful leadership team He has provided here in Clarksburg.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached about the Lord’s Vineyard Garden. Using Isaiah 5:1-7 and Matthew 21:33-44 as his text. The Lord’s kingdom in the earth is symbolized as a vineyard that God planted in a fruitful hill. The Lord is the owner, founder, and master of the vineyard. In the symbolic language of the vineyard, the Lord gathered out all the stones so the ground would be perfect for growing fruit, and he planted only the choicest vine. He built a tower in the vineyard, symbolic of blessing the church with His name. He also built a winepress in the vineyard, symbolic of blessing the church with His Spirit. In the symbolic passage in Isaiah 5:1-7, the Jews were the vineyard: The house of Israel was represented by the vineyard, and the men of Judah were represented by the pleasant plant in the vineyard. Nevertheless, the Jews rejected the Lord and were cut off by God. Now the Lord has turned to the Gentiles and has given his vineyard over to us, for a people that will honor Him as He should be honored. We should not gloat in this, because we were a wild branch grafted in. We could be cut off easily. We must stay true to God.</p>	<p>Elder David Harris preached “Interrupting Jesus” using Mark 5:25-34 as his text. Jesus said that if we will ask we will receive. Anytime we need something, all we have to do is ask. There was a woman who had an issue of blood twelve years. She had gone to many doctors, but instead of getting better she was getting worse. When this woman heard that Jesus was passing by, she interrupted Him. She knew that if she could just touch His clothes that she would be healed. The woman was immediately healed. Jesus loves to be interrupted. Interrupt Jesus by giving Him praise. We ask of Him again and again, but it really pleases Him to be interrupted with praise. Don’t worry about things that are going on about you. Interrupt Jesus! He loves it.</p>
