<p>Elder John Sandy taught “The Preacher’s Responsibility Concerning Doctrine.” I Tim. 4:13 “give attendance to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine.” Be strong; read your Bibles and study to show thyself approved unto God. Continue in the faith by exercising godliness, removing yourself from worldliness, staying in the word of God, staying focused on the things of God, and making sacrifices for God. Baptism means to be completely immersed in water as Jesus was completely immersed in the tomb. When King Tut was buried they put many expensive treasures in the tomb with him. Years later when the tomb was opened, King Tut was still inside the tomb. King Jesus has spiritual treasures in the tomb with Him. He has souls of men, women, boys and girls who have been buried with Him. When we are baptized, we are buried with Him. Romans 6:4 “Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death” We can’t be saved by works alone, but we must have works: James 2:17 “Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.” Repentance is a work; water baptism is a work. A person who believes and loves God will come up out of the water a new person. The water has no magic powers. The person believes God and is going to do exactly what God says to do. When Naaman dipped himself seven times in the Jordan River, he was cleansed of leprosy because he did exactly what God told him to do. Madison Colombo was water baptized in Jesus name. She added more treasure to Jesus’ tomb.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Take Me to the Water” using Hebrews 11: 1-2, 5-7 and James 2:19-22. Water baptism is essential. Having faith is a work of God. Obedient faith is when you put your head in the Book and find out what God wants you to do, and then do it. Unless we are born again of the water (baptism) and Spirit (Holy Ghost) we can’t see God. When Peter preached on the day of Pentecost, they asked him, “What shall we do?” Peter answered, “Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.” (Acts 2:38) Baptism is not just a show, but for the remission of sins. By faith we go down in the water knowing our sins are washed away. Joshua circumcised the children of Israel. “And the Lord said unto Joshua, This day have I rolled away the reproach of Egypt from off you...” (Joshua 5:9) Baptism is a circumcision made without hands.
