It is a very strong tree; in fact, the word cedar is derived from a word that means firm, strong or to make strong. Cedar wood doesn't crack and break when it is dried out, nor does it lose its shape when it gets wet. It doesn't rot, and it resists mildew as well as insects and bugs. It doesn't curl up or bend out of shape when it isn't treated the way it is used to. We, as Christians, must be like cedar wood. We must thrive in any situation or condition; in a group of fellow believers or all alone. We must not allow outside influences to destroy us, nor the enemy's attack to break us down. We must live in a harsh, dry world without warping or breaking apart. Whatever we are called to do we must accomplish without fail. We are in the Master's hands for Him to use us as He sees fit. Cedar wood was the wood chosen for the temple. It housed the presence of God in the wilderness. We are chosen for the Spirit of God to dwell in the wilderness today. We must strive to do and accomplish our calling without failure in whatever capacity God places us, like cedar wood.</p>

**Parenting Insight You Can Use Now** - When kids whine, argue, complain, or otherwise engage in manipulative techniques, stop talking about the issue and instead draw attention to the process. The process is the way we're relating. Too many parents continue to talk about the cookie, or dirty shirt, or movie. Stop talking about the issue and move to the process to teach children that the way they address problems is important. You might say, "I've already said no to your request. Do you see how you're treating me now because you aren't getting what you want?" Or, "You've stopped asking and started whining. I've already said no to your request for now, but I've told you yes for next week. But if you continue to whine about it, the answer for next week will become a no, too." This simple switch can help you address the more important solutions kids need to learn in family life.
