<p>Elder Lorren Godwin taught about making Jesus our refuge. He used Joshua 20:1-4 as his main text. We need a refuge from the enemy. We need to make Jesus our hiding place. Jesus is salvation—a refuge for us. Under Mosaic law, there were six Cities of Refuge for the twelve tribes of Israel. If anyone accidentally killed someone, he or she could run to one of these cities and find refuge, spared from revenge at the hands of the victim’s family. Today we go to Jesus for refuge. Upon entering a City of Refuge, the pursued would meet the leaders of the city and plead his case. If the death was ruled accidental or unintentional, he would be allowed to stay in the city. He was safe as long as he stayed there. He was required to stay in the city until the death of the high priest, which meant a new beginning, just like the death of Jesus means for us. Then the man could return home. That’s like the grace of Jesus. If we call out to Him when we have committed sins, and the blood of Jesus can cover us. As long as we dwell in the presence of Jesus, the enemy cannot get to us to accuse or avenge.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Don’t Be Bound To The Mast” using Matthew 14:24-33. Fear is an arch enemy of faith. The devil can’t lay a finger on us without permission from God. Don’t live a life of fear. The just shall live by faith. When we are tossed with waves and the wind is contrary, Jesus can come walking on the water and give us victory. He told the troubled disciples, “Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.” God is still telling us when danger comes, “Do not fear.” When we face danger, Jesus is with us. Don’t permit fear to keep you bound to the mast. Have faith. Peter walked on the water until he saw the wind boisterous. If he had not feared, he could have kept walking on the water. When doubt and fear move in, faith moves out. The moment Peter doubted, he started to sink. “And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him”. Jesus didn’t let Peter drown simply because he doubted. Don’t stay bound to the mast. Get out and “walk on the water.” If you fail, Jesus is present. Trust Him!</p>	<p>Pstr Joseph preached “Unshakeable” from II Kings 2:1-11. Elisha ignored all attempts to separate him from Elijah on the day Elijah was taken into heaven. He said, “As the Lord liveth, and as thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee.” Because he was unshakeable, he received a double portion of Elijah’s anointing. We must be determined that nothing can separate us from God or His people. An Elisha determination results in Elijah anointing! A dead soldier was thrown into the tomb of Elisha, and the prophet’s bones resurrected the soldier. Resurrection awaits us when we’re buried with the Church that went before us. They connect us to Jesus. In touching the true, holy Church, we make contact with the Lord Jesus Christ. Let’s be unshakeable! Stay in the Church, and stay with Jesus.</p>
