In Acts 3:1-8, Peter said to a lame man who was laid daily at a gate of the temple, “Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.” Peter took him by the hand and lifted him up. Because Peter took that risk, the man was healed. In Acts 10, Peter went to the home of Cornelius, a Gentile. Because Peter took that first step, the Gentiles received the Holy Ghost. Be bold!
