False prophets will come to the churches and tell people that all they have to do to be saved is believe on Jesus; that we can do what we want; that we don't need the Holy Ghost-just anything false. Jesus said "he that doeth the will of my father" will enter into heaven. Jesus told Peter "upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." The rock is Jesus Christ We must be built upon the rock. It is time to look up for our redemption draweth nigh. On the day of judgement we had better have the works of Jesus in our life. Don't live 37%-54%-97% for Jesus. We must live 100% for Him or we won't make it. Jesus is our source, not drugs or anything this world will offer. Keep your mind made up "I'm built on a rock."</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught. In Ephesians 4:8, Paul cited Psalm 68:18. Paul's reference to Jesus' descent that occurred <i>before He ascended</i>, refers to the same descent as described in 1 Peter 3, during which the bodiless human essence of the crucified Christ descended into the Abode of the Dead where He preached to the souls held captive there. Later came His ascension and resurrection, etc. Thus, Psalms 16:10 was quoted by Peter at Pentecost in Acts 2:27, in reference to Jesus: "thou wilt not leave by soul in hell." From Jesus' account of the rich man and Lazarus in Luke 16, we see that, before the cross of Christ, the souls of the righteous dead were held in the Abode of the Dead, which was divided into two compartments, a place of comfort and a place of torment. And we know that, after the cross, the souls of the righteous dead do not go down to Hell, but rather ascend and reside with the Lord; Paul wrote that "to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord." O.T. saints were brought up from Hell. But we will be raptured from Earth!</p>
