Hannah wanted something she couldn’t have—a boy child. But she prayed! The reason some of us need something is because God wants us to learn to pray during our difficulties. God may allow us to be vexed. God wants us to learn to pray in our vexations. Hannah was childless; she was vexed, so she prayed. God can solve all our problems. Hannah poured out her soul before God. There shouldn’t be empty seats in our church. We need more Hannahs. Whenever Zion travails, then sons and daughters will be born into the church. We need to pray for revival. There is a blessing to those who are diligent in performing God’s will. God wants us to pray, but He desires our praise, too. You may miss an appointment, but don’t miss talking to God. When Jesus speaks to you just say “Here am I, Lord. Your servant is listening!”</p>	<p>Guest speaker Rev. Jonathan Milam preached “The Reward of The Diligent” using Hebrews 11:5-6. Without faith it is impossible to please God. Enoch had this testimony: that he pleased God. God is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Whatever we do in Jesus’ name, we must be diligent. Joash smote the arrows as Elisha told him, but only thrice instead of five or six times. His lack of diligence diminished God’s promise of smiting the enemy. We must be diligent in praying, in praise, in worship, and in all things pertaining to God. A lack of diligence will mean a reducing of His promises for us.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Tabitha & Eutychus” using Acts 9:36-43, 20:7-12. Tabitha’s name means <i>Gazelle</i>. She was full of good works and almsdeeds. She grew sick and died. Peter prayed for her and God raised her from the dead. The name Eutychus means <i>fortunate</i>. He was a Gentile boy who fell asleep during church, fell out a window, down three stories, and died. Paul prayed, and God raised him up too. Some people are like gazelles: graceful and powerful & deserving. Most are like the boy: we don’t deserve God’s grace, we’re just fortunate. God offers His greatest gifts, such as salvation, to all who come to Him by faith, regardless of whether we are Jew or Gentile, a “deserving” person or not, dedicated ... or just fortunate. God is gracious and loving to each one of us the same. In one parable, Jesus told of a man who hired workers to work in his harvest field. He paid the ones who were hired the eleventh hour the same as those who were hired the first hour. Even when we don’t deserve it, God will help us.</p>

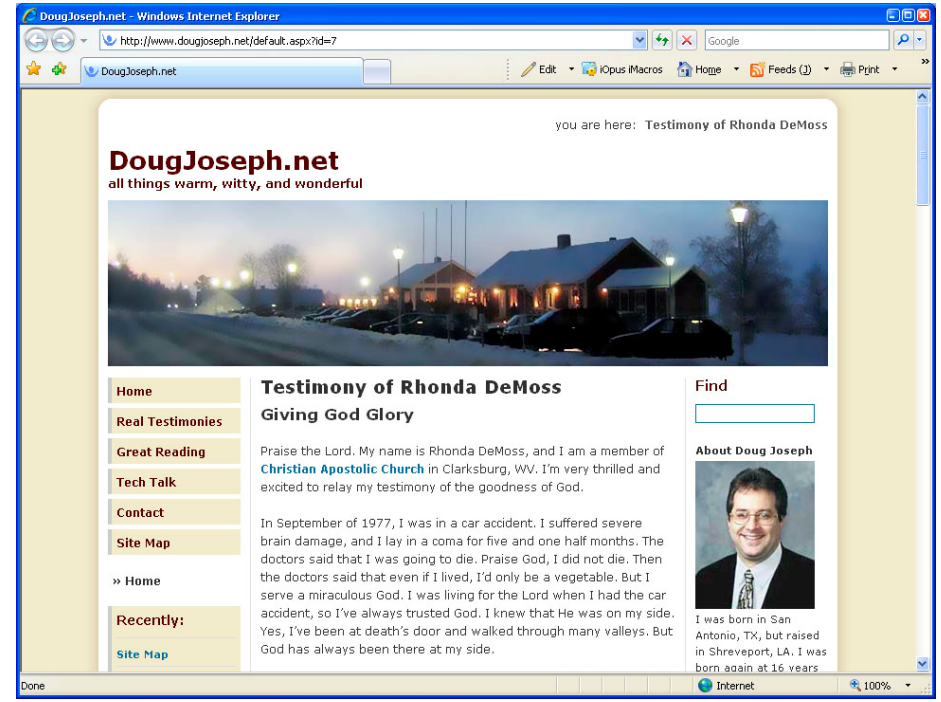
