We have to have our mind set to change the world. When everyone else gives up, we must push through. If we go in Jesus name, anything is possible. Our greatest enemy is ourselves. We sometimes walk around scared of the devil when he should be scared of us. We need to have our mind set on faith. The devil's only power is but a bag of tricks. If we keep our mind on Jesus we won't fail. We should think on things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of good report. Don't think negatively or talk negatively. Do not worry about what others think. Worry about your relationship with God. Our mindset determines how our victory is won. Too many times we go to battle with our mind set for defeat. God tells us to not worry about battles coming our way. The mind of faith always remembers that He's already fought for us and won. We ought to keep the mind of faith!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "There Shall Be Light at the Evening Time" using Zechariah 14:5-9, 12-14, 16-21 and Revelation 11:15-17. <b>Eschatology</b> is the biblical study of the end-time. It literally means "study of the last days." Some deep aspects of Eschatology are difficult to fathom, but some basics are very clear. Our current age will culminate with the rapture of the church and the personal, bodily appearing of the Lord Jesus. The Bible prophesies that the nations of the earth will attack Jerusalem. Then Jesus will appear and fight against the wicked. He came first to die as Savior. He will return as Judge and King. God designed things so that the normal process of our current life is a dual-pole (bipolar) system: Day &amp; night, heat &amp; cold, seed &amp; harvest, wake and sleep, etc. But just as light is dual-nature (both bipolar wave form and non-polar particle beam), Jesus (the light of the world) is dual-nature (man and God). When He comes to destroy the wicked, He will reveal another reality beyond the normal bipolar flow of things: At evening time, it shall be light. There is a place in God we can get to where we are not bipolar; but rather "just right" all the time. We'll never be tired, sick, mad, cranky or grumpy. The wicked who love darkness will be judged once and for all. We're to walk in the light with Christ &amp; rule with Him!</p>	<p>An awesome Thanksgiving service was held this eve. 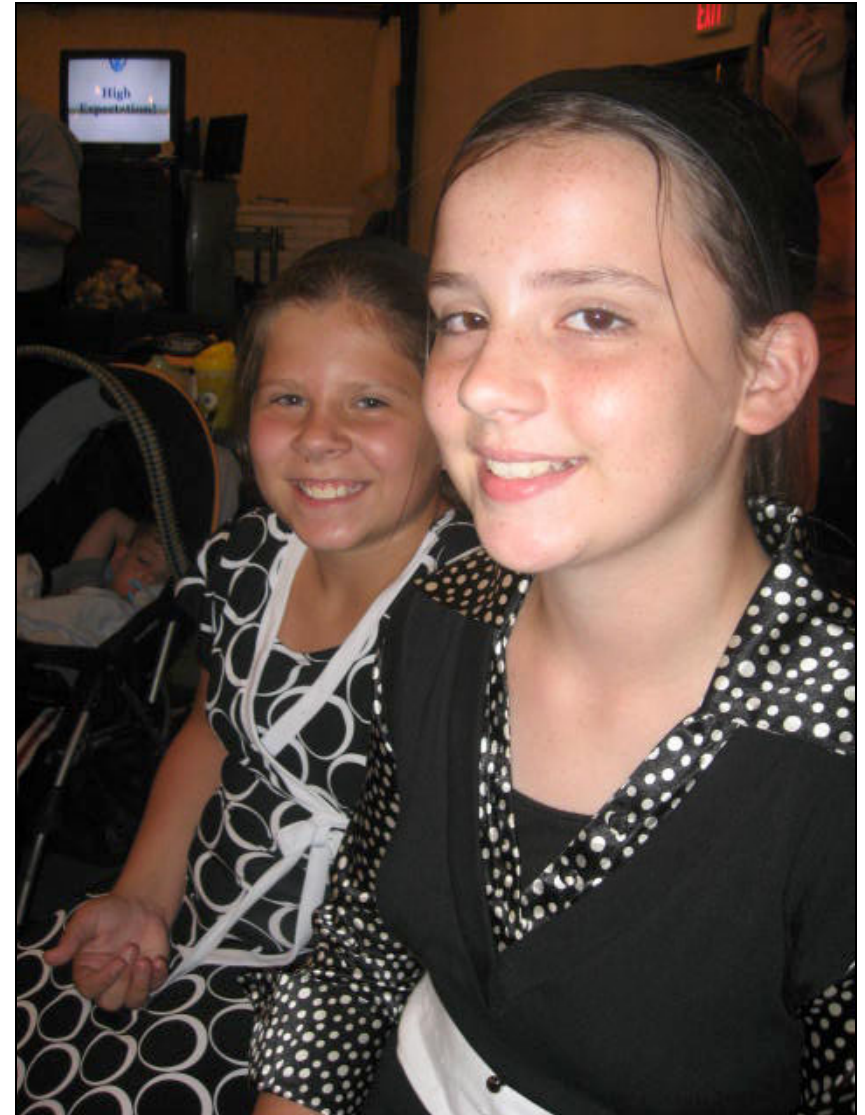
