<p>Elder David Harris preached “Let the Real Apostolic Stand Up” using I Peter 5:7. We have to get to the place where Apostolic doctrine comes out wherever we go. The Apostolic faith is the real thing. “Let the real Apostolic stand up.”</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Distractions at Harvest Time” using II Kings 4:17-23, 30-34. God swore an oath that all the families of the earth would be blessed through Abraham’s seed. The primary fulfillment of the prophecy was Jesus. But we are also a secondary fulfillment. If we are baptized in Jesus’ name and filled with God’s Spirit, we are Abraham’s seed. Elisha prophesied to a Shunammite woman that she would have a child, a promised son. It came true. But later on that same child became ill—<u>during harvest time</u>. The father avoided being distracted from the harvest and sent the child to the mother. Then their son died. She went to the man of God with faith that all would be well. He resurrected the boy! We must not allow the problems happening around us to distract us from the harvest. Keep reaching the lost with truth. We can see a great harvest, helping souls come into the Kingdom of God by witnessing & testifying. We can see the promise revived if we stretch ourselves in faith!</p>	<p>Brother Lenny Smith and his wife, full time UPCI missionaries to Antigua, were with us for this service. The Smith’s showed pictures and video of the great revival God has poured out there, and the church building that they and the people there are building as a place of worship for the Lord Jesus. He also preached a great message to the church. God has blessed the church with power to witness, by pouring out His Spirit into our hearts and lives. But sometimes we run away from the task of preaching to the lost, like Jonah did. Then we might think there is no hope to get back on the right track. But God can always help us. After Jonah ran, and boarded a ship going in the wrong direction, God allowed a terrible storm to rise up. When the men of the ship found out, they threw Jonah overboard. God worked a miracle to save Jonah and sent Him to the right place by having a great fish to be in the right place at the right time. God can send us just what we need at the right place and time!</p>
