Joseph sang "There's a Promise Coming Down a Dusty Road" and then Pastor Joseph ministered. The Spirit of the Lord moved in an awesome way. If we are burned out, we need to pray more. We worry too much in trying to handle our tasks in our own strength. But God intended for us to have His help. If we would just ask God, He will help. We should care a little less what other people think. Some matters are our own business, between us and God. We need to talk to God more. When we get a hold to God, we can avoid the "crash and burn" of going it alone. We need the help of God in everything. We should not just sit in church and then go home the same way. In John 15:2-7 Jesus said that every branch that bears not fruit is taken away, but if we abide in Him, He will abide in us. Plug into Him and His power. In Luke 11:9 Jesus said, "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." Jesus is the answer.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught on the topic of mercy versus judgment, especially in regard to church discipline. According to Matthew 18, the local church ("gathering of the called-out ones") has been entrusted with broad authority to maintain discipline among its members, and Heaven backs up the judgments of the church in cases of discipline. In the worst of cases, the church can reject divisive people, and can put out ("excommunicate") sinful members who refuse to repent of serious, ongoing sin. However, this should be a last resort. According to Matthew 24 and Luke 11, Jesus is not pleased with people who, though they may be experts in studying the Word of God, use their knowledge only to nitpick and judge others, demanding the most exacting perfection from people, while refusing to help anyone achieve it. I.E. If we hope that people will dress more holy and modest, we should offer to buy them clothes, not just condemn them for their sins. Have mercy!</p>
