<p>Elder David Harris preached “Here Comes The Church” using Isaiah 60: 1. Our Holy Ghost light will shine out to the world. <i>Here comes the church.</i> We may not understand why nothing happens sometimes when we pray. But <i>here comes the Bride.</i> We have to get to the place that we grip the altar and believe in faith. When we lose someone to the grave, our hearts are saddened. But it’s a happy time for they are with the Lord. Peter was asleep, not knowing what would happen to him in the morning. Prayer without ceasing was going up for him. We’re in a spiritual warfare. We need to flex our spiritual muscles. The gates of hell will not come against the church. <i>Here comes the Bride!</i> The devil has activity and power but with the Holy Ghost we have dominion and authority over the devil. <i>Here comes the Bride.</i> Let the devil know who’s boss. We must realize the devil is scared of true Holy Ghost power. <i>Here comes the church!</i> Resist the devil and say “I’ve come to win in Jesus!”</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Ministering to Those in Need” using Job 14 1-13 and II Corinthians 12: 7-11. We live a holy life because we believe with all of our heart that Jesus will split the eastern skies. We must live holy to be ready for the coming of the Lord. Jesus is coming back! Anyone who tries to discredit the coming of the Lord is trying to discredit Christianity. If you fall and commit a sin, get back up, repent and move on. You can’t take your belongings to Heaven. The only thing that is going to heaven is people. Why does God allow suffering and death in my life if I am a Christian? When we get suffering and death in our lives, we get what we deserve. When we get healing and an answer to prayer we get what we don’t deserve. We must accept the bad as well as the good. God gives and He takes away. The greatest success in trial is to maintain one’s faith even if God chooses not to give us a miracle. His grace is sufficient for us and His strength is made perfect in weakness.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached an animated message entitled “Shadow and Reality.” He was aided by many of the youth and children who helped by serving as symbols to illustrate the sermon. He used Colossians 2:1-17 as his text. Under the Mosaic Covenant, a Gentile had to become Jewish in order to become part of the Kingdom of God. Such a Gentile had to willingly seek to obey all the ceremonial practices of the Jews, according to the Mosaic Law, as pertains to rituals &amp; diet. When the New Covenant came into effect, some Christianized Jews thought that all Gentiles under the New Covenant would also have to become Jewish in their practices of diet and ceremonial rituals. But the Apostles taught against that, and the New Testament reveals why. Those Jewish rituals and dietary codes, etc, were prophetic symbols to foreshadow the New Testament reality we have now in Jesus. Circumcision was one example, foreshadowing water baptism in Jesus.</p>
