

<p>Elder Charles Hoskins preached “What Deal Are You Looking For?” using Matthew 16:13-19. God exists in the past, present and future. His Word is everlasting. The Kingdom of God is within us. People are hungry and searching. Are you looking for a deal with a guarantee? Jesus is the deal. We have to desire the Lord. Jesus is the living water. We must have a deal with a guarantee. Jesus Christ has the complete deal. God’s Word is truth. It comes against the abnormal ways our society has. We need to listen when God talks to us in the quiet times. We cannot afford to allow the devil to infect us with sin and contaminate us. He has no authority over us. We can’t allow him to invade our mind. God’s Word goes into our heart and has an effect on us. It will change our desires. It will reveal what’s hidden. We must incline our ear to God’s Word to receive understanding. What kind of deal is this? He paid it ALL for us!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Peace or Poison?” using Genesis 13:13 and Luke 10:10-12. The beggar, blind Bartimaeus, made a choice. He chose to cry out to Jesus to help him; to not stay blind. And as he did so immediately he received his sight. There are some who prefer to suffer & complain, rather than receive a healing, choosing a beggar’s coat over of a miracle. Each of us has a choice. We can either choose peace (the Lord’s salvation) or poison (the way of death). When Jesus sent fore-runners to the cities, He told them that when they went into a house, to put their peace on it. If they were received, it would stay. If not, their peace would return to them. He said that in the Judgment Day, it would be more tolerable for Sodom than for a city that rejected His messengers. When one rejects our preaching, he or she is rejecting God! We are preaching the message of peace. God wants people to repent, be baptized in Jesus name, and to receive the Holy Ghost. Some choose not to. Obey & choose peace!</p>	<p>The worship service was awesome as souls rejoiced and danced in the spirit. Elder John Sandy exhorted the church not to let “stuff” get in the way and block out the light of the Lord. Pastor Joseph preached using James 4:8-10. He illustrated how sin isolates one away from God and other people, by telling a story (as a parable) about a man stranded on a deserted island. When stranded, he tries to preserve himself by sending out a message in a bottle. In the same way, our carnal nature will do anything to preserve itself. Anything to keep from dying. But the Lord has decreed not only that salvation required His death on the cross, but also we must die out to sin by repenting. Just as Jesus was buried in the tomb, we get buried with Him by water baptism in Jesus name. And just as Jesus came up from the tomb, we come up from the water with new life, by the power of the Holy Ghost! Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you. Die out to the world, and choose God!</p>
