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| <p>Elder David Harris preached “Surprise The Enemy” using Judges 7. God will deliver us and send His angels to protect us and to fight for us. We have had services of crescendos of praise because we have taken all of our weaknesses and problems to God in praise. We have put a surprise attack on the enemy. The devil is not everywhere. He cannot be. He sends his little demons to attack. We just rebuke them in Jesus’ name and they have to flee. When people feel fear come upon them they need to remember how powerful God is. We can use His name to make the devil flee. Preachers fight spiritually for the saints. The Word of God reveals spiritual battles through preaching. “When the devil comes a messin, Jesus comes a blessin!” A message is just a “mess” that is “aged.” This week when the devil messes with you just praise the Lord and SURPRISE THE ENEMY.</p> | <p>Elder David Harris preached “Go One More Time” using II Kings 5:1. Naaman, a great and honorable Syrian captain, was a leper. He came to Elisha, a man of God, for healing. Elisha sent word to Naaman to go and dip in the Jordan River seven times and he would be cleansed. All that God has promised will come to pass. When Joshua and his men had compassed the city of Jericho seven times God told them to “Shout; for the Lord hath given you the city” (Joshua 6:16). After six, go one more time! The woman with the issue of blood spent all that she had and got no better. But she went on and touched Jesus! She pressed her way through the crowd and touched the hem of His garment and she was healed. We need to seek God just one more time; pray one more time; fast one more time; witness one more time. Go into the realm of Holy Ghost one more time! Get hungry for more of the moving of God’s Spirit. GO ONE MORE TIME!</p> | <p>Pastor Joseph taught a lesson about the name of the Lord, from Numbers 27:12-23. The name “Joshua” (in the Old Testament) and “Jesus” (in the New Testament) are different spellings of the very same name, which means YHVH-Salvation (i.e. Yahweh-Salvation, or Jehovah- Salvation). Moses was not to lead the people into the Promised Land. That was to be Joshua’s privilege. In the same way, also the Mosaic Covenant can’t make us perfectly acceptable to God. That is Jesus’ privilege via the New Covenant. Only the blood of Jesus and the name of Jesus can wash away our sins. The name of Jesus is powerful. Yet it does not cause power for “just anyone.” It is not some kind of magical sound, not some kind of “incantation” which evil people can use to get results. The power in His name is because of God’s power, and that power only works for those who have a relationship with Him. It’s not how you hold your mouth when you say the name of Jesus. No, it’s how you live. Do you know Jesus?</p> |
