<p>Elder Hoskins preached from II Chronicles 7:14-15. God has a “burning bush” even to this day! It is the Church, and it will not be consumed! “If my people which are called by my name [the name of the living God, Jesus] shall humble themselves and pray... [We must be humble when we approach God. If there is brokenness, He’ll see our sincerity] ...then will I...heal their land.” God always provided for the people of Israel. He made for Himself a people from those who were not a people. When the children of Israel were slaves, unaccustomed to liberty, with no place of security, God was willing to help them. God was willing to implant His character in them; He pulled them out of Egypt and made them a people. Looking back over the years we can see God’s blessings. The promise of God covers us. He surrounds us and protects us. God gives us favor. But first we must obey Him. We must be willing to follow God’s plan.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Hide and Seek” using John 7:1-10 & Jeremiah 29:10-14. In God’s work, timing is very important. If you wait until you feel prepared to do a work for God, you’ll never do it. God knows when the time is right. He looks on the heart. Beware when the world loves you and speaks well of you. God called us out of this world. We live to please God, not the world. We don’t come to church just to please the pastor. We come seeking the Lord, and to please Him. We need the Lord’s help to better ourselves in all aspects of our life—our marriage, our family life, jobs and our covenant with God. The Lord has promised that in the day that we would seek for Him with our whole heart, He would be found of us. It’s Him hiding and us seeking. God’s hidden secret is that He found a way to show us mercy without setting his judgments aside. How? He robed Himself in flesh, in Jesus, and poured out all His judgments for sin upon Himself. Now we can have God hidden in us! Seekers see Him in us.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “To Serve and Protect.” In the beginning, God planted a garden eastward in Eden. He put Adam in the garden, and gave him the duty to tend and keep it. Just as Adam was charged with serving and protecting God’s garden, we are to be good stewards over the blessings God has entrusted to us. As godly parents, we are to raise our children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. Children are the heritage of the Lord. God assigns parents the role of guarding, serving, protecting, teaching, and guiding our children. It is a responsibility assigned by God, and we should not let government take our teaching duty away. An old saying goes “Familiarity breeds contempt.” There is some truth in that. However, one <i>can</i> maintain respect for authority even while very familiar with the leader who holds that authority. Some parents think they cannot allow their children to become “familiar” with godly leaders, but the Bible teaches us differently.</p>
