As we meet with pressures of life, let us give love away.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Loyalty” using I Kings 19:1-3, 15-19 and II Kings 2:1-6, 11-12. God is perfect and that makes it easy for man to be loyal to Him. Man is not perfect and therefore it is hard to be loyal to him. Of course, we should be loyal to God first, over any man. However, it is a false doctrine that we should trust no man, having loyalty to no man. “Church” means the gathering of the Called Out Ones. We should be loyal to one another. There is no church of perfect people. We will not be perfect until we get to the other side. The prophet Elijah was on the mountaintop at times, yet he was also in the valley at other times. We all have ups and downs. We should do our best to be loyal to our brothers and sisters whether we are up or down. Some people will use almost any excuse to stop being loyal. But many times the mistake just doesn’t warrant that. As much as possible, stay loyal to your pastor and your bother and sister in the Lord. Say, “I will not leave nor forsake thee.”</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a lesson about stress. He took his text from Ecclesiastes 3:18 (“To everything there is a season”). Even a season for stress? Yes. We don’t want to live with stress, but if you don’t have any, your local address is probably the cemetery. We’ve been programmed to believe that stress is bad and that we should do everything we can to eliminate it. But that’s not really true. Without stress, we wouldn’t be on top of our game. We wouldn’t make sure the reports we have to do were done at all, let alone on time. Without it our kids would never make their beds or clean their rooms. Without it, we’d probably end up couch potatoes with zero intellect and without a life. Just as a rubber band can’t do its job unless it’s tight enough for some stress, we need a healthy amount of stress in our lives. And just as a rubber band can snap when too much stress is applied, so it is with us. Being totally stress-free should not be our goal. We all should remember that sometimes God leads us to a place where some stress will motivate us.</p>
