Abraham was a great man, blessed with family, herds and wealth. He had great faith in God. When Abraham was old, he called his trusted servant to him, and had him swear an oath to find a good wife for his son Isaac. Choose your spouse wisely! Don't marry someone who's not in the church! Just like Abraham's servant who sought a bride for his master's son, our pastor is a servant of who is seeking a Bride for the Son of God. The bride had to accept it. We must choose this day who we will serve. As Rebekah answered "I will go", we must be obedient to be the Bride of Jesus. Her family wanted her to stay a few days longer. Some people want to live in their sins a little longer. But if you believe, you will obey today! Rebekah obeyed, even though she had never seen Isaac. We obey, even though we have never seen Jesus. One day she finally saw him. One day we will see JESUS!	Elder David Harris preached using Galatians 3:5 and 20-25. We all need faith. It takes faith to receive the Holy Ghost. Our faith and our fasting will help our infirmities. God won't live in an unclean temple. Faith keeps us going. It will help us when everything around us is going wrong. Abel, Enoch, Noah, Abraham and Sarah "all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off". Today we have the promise. We have the Holy Ghost. Keep the faith; keep praying; keep fasting. Sometimes we don't know what we should pray for "but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us". (Romans 8:26) If you don't talk to God, you won't have a relationship with Him. Faith is going to get us through. You have to talk to Him. Keep holding on!

Sunday, August 3 – At the annual Sunday School Picnic

Pastor Joseph taught a brief Sunday School lesson about the difference between Hell and the Lake of Fire (they are not the same), and some differences between the spirit realm and the natural realm, and between being with Jesus in Heaven (as a bodiless spirit after death but before resurrection) and being with Jesus on the New Earth (ruling with Him in our resurrected, glorified bodies). He explained that many scriptures lead Bible scholars to believe that prior to the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus, all the souls of the dead (both righteous and wicked) went down to the Abode of the Dead (called Hell in the Bible).

Back then, Hell had two areas, or compartments: one of comfort for the righteous who died in faith, waiting on the Messiah to come, and another compartment of torment where the wicked dead suffered in punishment. However, there was a change made after Jesus' death. The Bible teaches that the soul of Jesus (bodiless) went to the Abode of the Dead and preached to the spirits held captive there. Then, when He ascended, the Bible says He "led captives in His train" which is understood to mean He led the righteous dead out of the "comfort" part of Hell, and took them to Heaven with Him. There is no longer any place of comfort in Hell; it is now only a place of torment. The Bible prophesies that "death and hell were cast into the lake of fire." One day the wicked dead will get bodies and, in them, suffer in the Lake of Fire. The righteous dead currently wait in paradise with the Lord until their resurrection, after which they shall reign with Christ upon the New Earth.

Junior Elder Rusty Sandy preached using Matthew 6:33 and Acts 1:8 and 2:38-47. We are strong. God has given us power so that we are strong in the Spirit. "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you" (Acts 1:8). Get excited! God has given you power. When you come to church, don't just sit relaxed during the preaching of God's Word. Get involved! When Peter first preached on the Day of Pentecost, three thousand souls were added to the church. We have power over Satan and all evil. The Holy Ghost will set us free. We have a right to praise Him. Don't give this power up for any of the "stupid" things that Satan offers. There's nothing out in the world worth leaving the church for. Don't let anyone take this power from you.
