<p>Evangelist Justin Meadors preached “Can You Play the Evil Spirit Away?” using I Samuel 16:13-23. Just playing music or singing, or even praying and praising doesn’t justify a result from God; it has to be anointed of God. When Paul and Silas were beaten and put in jail, they prayed and sang praises to God. They would have most likely perished if it wasn’t for their anointed praise. When you see a brother or sister in need, all you have to do is lay your anointed hands upon them and evil spirits will flee. God’s anointing can break every yoke. Resist evil spirits when they come to torment you. “Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.” (James 4:7)</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Cover Me” using John 1:6-9, 29. God cares about how we dress. People who run around half dressed have the devil in them. We should be modestly dressed showing forth a Godly image. When Adam and Eve disobeyed God by eating of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, they instantly realized their nakedness and sewed fig leaves together. They hid from God. Sin separates us from God. God told Adam the fig leaves wouldn’t do the job. An animal would have to die to cover them. When we sin we hide from God. The blood shed on the cross is our sin covering. God cares about the covering on the outside, but also the inside. Baptism in Jesus’ name is not an option; it’s a must. Obey the gospel by obeying Acts 2:38. Repent, be baptized in Jesus’ name and receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. This is our covering. Stay under this covering. Are we clothed properly in the presence of God?</p>
