Rain is a symbol of the presence of God. The spirit of God is living water. The same God that poured out judgment on the children of disobedience will pour out His spirit(rain) on those who obey Him. We need the rain. Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord. Appealing to God’s grace is more effective than anything else. Men mocked and ridiculed Noah as he preached, and they ignored the warning. But one day God shut the door and the rain came. Jesus is coming back after His children who have been made free from sin. We need to get ready before He shuts the door. We need the spirit of the Lord always to rain down on us.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Have Your Cake and Eat It Too” using I Kings 17:13 as his text. The Lord chose to preserve Elijah the prophet during a time of drought and famine by assigning a widow woman to feed him. But it was going to take an act of faith and obedience on her part in order for the man of God to be fed, and her faith was going to not only preserve the man of God, but also bring about a miracle that saved both her and her son from starvation during the drought. She was down to the last of her flour and oil, and was about to make the last bit bread before they were to starve, when along came the prophet, and in a request that might have sounded selfish, but was really based on the word of God, he asked her to bake him a cake first. She obeyed. There is a dynamic here: She baked one in anticipation of baking another. And this act of obedience activated a miracle in the barrel of meal and the cruise of oil. For the duration of the drought, there was always one more cup of meal and a few more drops of oil.</p>
