<p>Pastor Joseph taught a study asking, “Who were the ‘sons of god’ in Genesis 6?” At least three theories suggest meaning for the “sons of god.” (1) they were sinful angels (2) Descendents of Seth (a righteous “line” of humans) (3) Another view, not well known, but well supported by scholarly research, is that they were wicked rulers in an age of so-called Divine Kings, in which the “divine” part was deliberately faked so they could rule. The angel view has problems. To have children, the angels must have had sex, and angels are neither male nor female. Angels are spiritual beings. The great Flood punished men (flesh), not spirits (see Gen 6:3). The “kids of Seth” theory seems possible, but has issues too. For believers and unbelievers to marry is against basic biblical principle. But does the punishment (the Flood) fit the crime? That would be against other biblical principles and is difficult to imagine. Pastor Joseph showed some scholarly support for the third view.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached from Hebrews 11:1-9 on the subject: “By Faith We Understand and Overcome.” Faith is certain of God’s promises (Heb. 11:1), is confident of God’s power (Heb. 11:1), and perceives the Divine design (Heb. 11:3). Faith acts on God’s promises (Heb. 11:8-22), esteems Christ above all (Heb. 11:26), and finally, faith overcomes tremendous odds (Heb. 11:29-38). God warned Noah, who believed God and thus obeyed. That is true faith. Notice the word warned. God has many times given warnings, and because people of faith have obeyed His warnings, lives have been saved, and even wars have been averted. Look at II Kings 6:8-23 to see but one example of many. We can be warned by God through reading and learning God’s law, and by having the fear of God in our hearts (see Psalm 19:7-11). And to have His daily guidance, each of us must have the Spirit of the Lord in us, so we can truly have the Wisdom from God that He imparts by His Spirit.</p>	<p>Associate Pastor David Harris preached “Protect The Anointing” using Isaiah 10:27 &amp; 14:25. God’s anointing upon us must be protected and cherished. The enemy would like to steal it, so we must protect our gift. This precious anointing is a gift for the young and the old. We need to stir up the gift of God within us. Do something for Jesus! Protect this gift of God! The anointing comes by the Holy Ghost in us, and it adds power and authority to our words. The world does not like the words of authority. But we need to work while it is still day, for the night comes when no man can work. The Lord may give us but one word to speak, and, through that one word, the Holy Ghost may touch someone to whom we’re speaking. We have to be willing to let the Holy Ghost flow through us. Speak the Word of God with boldness. We can give others what we have through the channel of the Holy Ghost. We’re covered by the blood of Jesus. Let’s protect and exercise the anointing of the Spirit of God in us.</p>

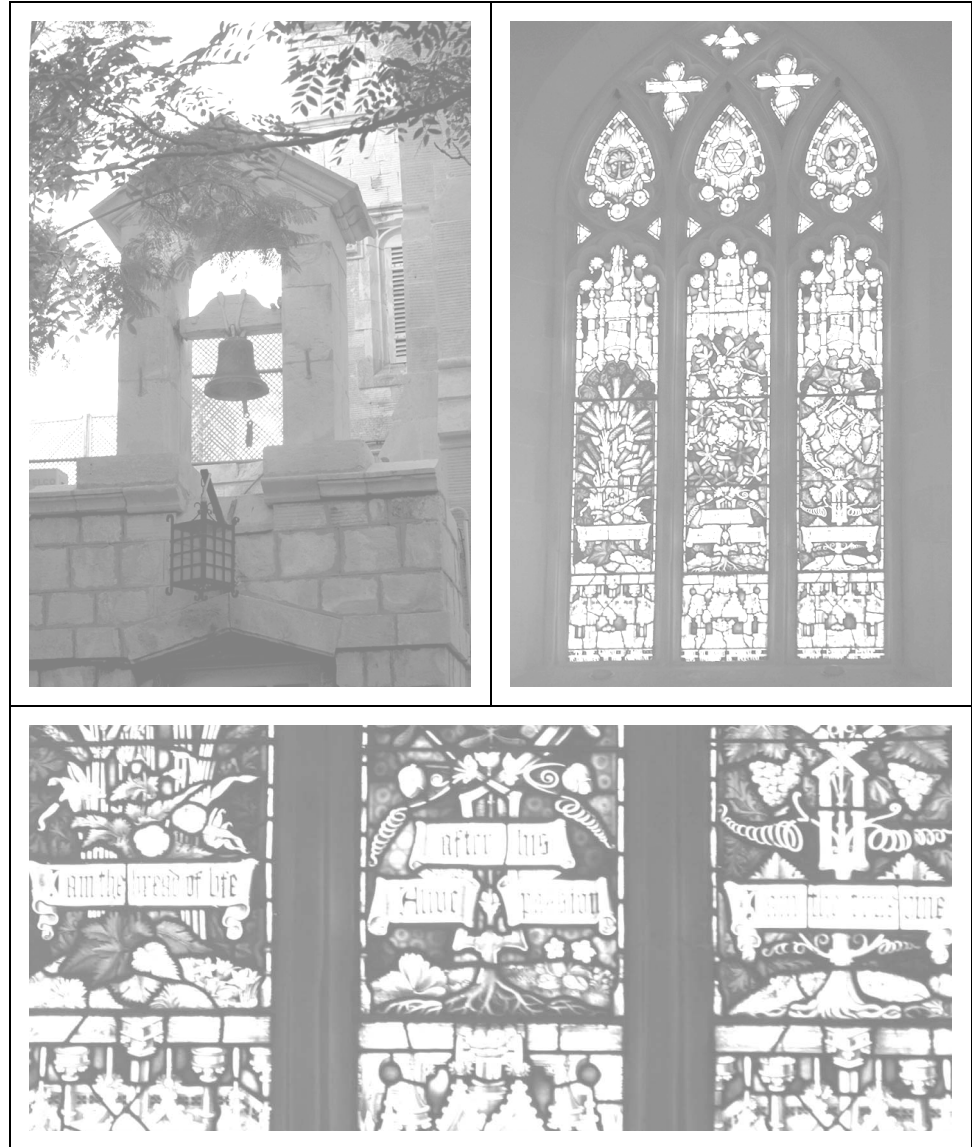
