

<p>Associate Pastor David Harris preached "What Are You Committed To?" using Genesis 18. We must be committed to winning souls for God. We can walk through a mall, the streets of town or even our own neighborhood and see souls bound for hell. God has given to each one of us the call to witness for Him. When we see a dirty, foul-smelling man, we see the outer man, but God sees his soul, the inner man. God can clean him up. That's not our job. It's our job to give him a Bible study, pray for him and baptize him. God will fill him with the Holy Ghost. When we first received the Holy Ghost, we were excited; ready to win the world. God expects us to follow through, and make good on our commitments. Those of us who have jobs are committed to our jobs. Why be less committed to the work of the Kingdom of God than we are to secular jobs? Let's keep our godly commitments. We need to commit ourselves to getting more sinners saved. God help us!</p>	<p>God had spoken to both Pastor Joseph and to Assoc. Pastor David Harris Jr, and so they tag team preached! Both messages were on worshipping God in advance for victory. Pastor Joseph's topic was "It's Time To Start Shouting!" and Elder Harris' topic was "It's Time To Start Singing!" Pastor Joseph read Joshua 6:1-5. Worship God in approach to your battles! When Joshua and all the people shouted for God with a great shout, the walls of the enemy's city came tumbling down! It takes faith to shout before we're healed, set free, or victorious. But <b>shout praises to God!</b> Elder Harris read 2 Chronicles 20:20-24, showing that when we go into battle praising God, we won't have to fight, because God will fight for us! Everyone in CAC had a praise for the Lord. Saints shouted, sang, danced, and jumped - praising God in different ways. <b>Ryann Ramsey, age 8, and Levi McClain, age 12, were filled with the Holy Ghost. Praise the Lord!</b></p>	<p>Pastor Joseph completed a study asking, "Who were the 'sons of god' in Genesis 6?" At least three theories suggest meaning for the "sons of god." (1) they were sinful angels, (2) Descendents of Seth (a righteous "line" of humans), (3) Another view, not well known, but well supported by scholarly research, is that they were wicked rulers in an age of so-called Divine Kings, in which the "divine" part was deliberately faked so they could rule. The angel view has problems. To have children, the angels must have had sex, and angels are neither male nor female. Angels are spiritual beings. The great Flood punished men (flesh), not spirits (see Gen 6:3). The "kids of Seth" theory seems possible, but has issues too. For believers and unbelievers to marry is against basic biblical principle. But does the punishment (the Flood) fit the crime? That would be against other biblical principles and is difficult to imagine. Pastor Joseph showed much scholarly support for the third view.</p>

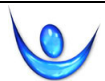
