Pastor Joseph preached a message entitled, "The God Makers", using Daniel 3:1 as his text. King Nebuchadnezzar made an image of gold, a huge idol (false god) that was ninety feet high and nine feet wide. He set it up and commanded all his subjects to worship the god that he had made. Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah (also known by assigned Babylonian names of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego) were the three Hebrew children who refused to bow down. They had been raised in the Jewish faith, not just in "weekly services" but schooled daily in Jewish academic religious schooling. They were later captured and forced to undergo three years of special "college" in Babylon, to learn worldly culture and literature. But it was not enough to undo their prior education! They refused to bow to the world's false gods. We need to be extra careful in training our kids in truth, utilizing daily, Christian, academic, religious education, to produce children strong against the "god makers."
