There’s a homecoming ready to happen. Don’t get relaxed in this time. Before we go home God wants to give us babies to take with us. We’re going to be changed. Nothing will harm us. We’ll have a body like Jesus. Death will be swallowed up. We need to make sure our name is written in the Lamb’s Book of Life. We have to make it; He’s coming quickly. We must fight with all we have if we want to go home with Jesus.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught “Promise to Abraham.” The lesson dealt with the Kingdom of God. Some Christians teach a false doctrine that Heaven and Hell are not real. They say that only the New Earth will exist during the future ages. Some other Christians teach an opposite false doctrine, saying Heaven and Hell are real, but that the New Earth will not exist during the future ages. The truth is that Heaven and Hell are real, and there will be a New Earth existing for all future ages. God made a covenant with Abram, and God changed his name to Abraham. God made some powerful promises to Abram. One of those promises was to give a great deal of land (a whole country, in fact) to Abram and to his descendents. This promise (and the land to which it referred) was a theme throughout the whole Bible. Abraham died without having been given that land. Yet the promise will be fulfilled, in the Resurrection, when Jews (some mortal, some immortal), will have the land God promised.</p>

## Seeing Evidence of God's Healing in Kallie Harris' Excellent Art Work



The above was drawn by Kallie Harris, who is in the process of being healed (of Autism) by the Lord. Pastor Doug Joseph, who is an artist and the Art Teacher for Apostolic Christian Academy, has analyzed Kallie's drawings and compared them with regular drawings by other children of her age. He said, "Autistic people, even children, have at times been known to demonstrate 'savant' (expert) brilliance in certain areas, which can include art. But while such people are powerfully enabled in the limited area of their gift, they are often non-functional outside their gift. I.E., such a child may draw or paint better than a greatly skilled adult, and yet be unable to function socially or in other ways. But Kallie's talent in art is more like that of a normal child of her age. And she is developing her social skills more and more over time. She is maturing into a wonderful young lady. We look forward to the day of her complete healing. Until then, we just treat her normally. We accept her as she is." Kallie is one of three daughters given by God to Bro. & Sis. David Harris Jr. Bro. Harris serves as CAC's Associate Pastor.
