<p>In the AM service, our Associate Pastor, David Harris Jr, preached “Winning A Battle With A Rock” using I Samuel 17: 49-50. When David went to battle against the Philistine giant, he only took a stone (a rock for his slingshot). Whatever battle we are going through, whether large or small, we need to have the Rock with us; that rock is Jesus. We can get this Rock within us by hiding the Word of God in our heart. Take heed to God’s Word. Know it, live it, embrace it; let it be a part of you. Then when battles come, you can stand with this Rock, just as David did, and prevail over your enemy. Moses sang a song about the Rock (in Deut. 32:3-4) saying how great and perfect is our God. “He is the Rock.” Jesus told us in Matt.16:18-19 that the church is built upon the Rock. No matter what battle we go through, we can prevail with our Rock; that Rock that is called Jesus.</p> <hr/> <p>In the PM service, the Lord led to have a testimonial service.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Are You A Servant or Status Seeker?” using I Samuel 16:1-14. Leadership is <i>influence</i>. Some mistakenly think leadership is having a title or an official position, but that is not really true leadership. The Lord is not calling us to be status seekers but servants and influencers. We should not live craving a position or title. Leadership is influence, and leadership is <i>plural</i> (a leader must be influencing someone else). One does not need a title to be an influencer of others. The Lord wants us to have a servant’s heart. David was a servant to his family and to their sheep. He was not bitter over his life as a servant and shepherd; He enjoyed his time as a servant. He even worshipped the Lord and wrote songs while working. In the midst of his cheerful service, God chose to give him a king’s crown. The pastor and leaders of the church aren’t supposed to be the only ones winning souls. Everyone in the church must be an influencer. The word <i>minister</i> means <i>servant</i>, and the word <i>ministry</i> means <i>service</i>. <u>Serving is the path to leadership</u>. This church is <i>our</i> church, not just “the pastor’s church.” True service is doing whatever needs done. If you’re a member of the church, there are at least three ways to refer to it: (1) <i>the</i> church or (2) <i>His</i> church or (3) <i>our</i> church. A true servant serves without demanding a crown.</p>

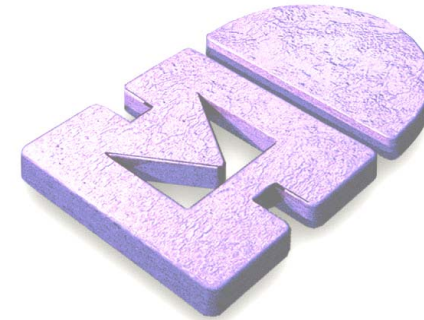

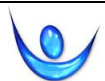
Request from Sis Rachel Claypool (via email):
