Then God will get His praise, and we will get our blessing.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Awake Out Of Sleep" using Genesis 2:21, 15:12 and 28:11,16. In the Bible, sleep can be physical, spiritual, or refer to death. Jacob was physically asleep on a bed of rocks, yet it was a place of spiritual blessing and he knew it not, until the Lord showed him in a dream. Abram, while trying to obey God in faith, fell into a deep sleep, and in a dream God told him about his future. God put Adam to sleep in the natural, and made his bride, Eve. It is always good to awake, whether to see what God has provided, or to stir from spiritual slumber, or to awake in resurrection from the dead. It is high time for us to awake out of sleep. "Church" means "the called out ones." The New Birth is itself an awaking from death. We're different, peculiar, special. We don't live as the world. Let's stay wide awake. Pray, fast, seek the Lord! And tell the gospel to the lost, so they can be awakened. The gospel is "the news of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection." Let's wake all with the news!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Love and Judge Not" using Romans 13:8,10 and 14:1-3. As we see the day approaching for the coming of the Lord, we need to be more and more loving to people. When we see someone who is not like us in all ways, too often we put ourselves into the Lord's place as though we can judge who is saved and who is not. We should not seek to make such judgments. As long as someone believes in the Bible and honors Jesus as Lord, we need to be willing to fellowship with them, if we are not required to violate our conscience to do so. We shouldn't judge, but rather see someone whom Jesus loves. Don't back up on truth. Walk in truth. But we are to be a people of love. Don't be judgmental or mean. <u>Speak the truth in love.</u> Be wise as serpents and harmless as doves.
