

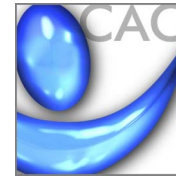

<p>Elder David Harris preached “I Need Some Vessels to Fill” using II Kings 4:1-6. We live in an “I” generation. iPod. iPhone. We need to be very careful not to let the “I” personality take over. The widow woman told Elisha, “Didn’t my husband serve you as the man of God?” That wasn’t an “I” generation. In Bible days you really served the man of God. The “I” generation has the attitude that I have to get myself ready and don’t worry about anyone else. This will cause you to back away from God. The widow told Elisha she needed help. Elisha told her to go to all her neighbors and get all the empty vessels she could find. We need to bring vessels to God. Bring them to the House of God to be filled. Elijah asked the widow of Zarepheth for a morsel of bread. She replied that she only had enough for her and her son. Elijah told her to give to him first and she would not run dry until it rained. Sometimes God can only get out attention by breaking us. We need the “I” spirit in us fixed.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “The Firm Hand of the Shepherd” using Psalm 51:6-8 and Isaiah 53:6. Sin always complicates things. We may ask the question “Why?” It’s because of the sin of Adam and Eve. There is none good but God. “All we like sheep have gone astray...” The firm hand of the shepherd help us back home and to not go astray. In the old days, whenever a lamb kept wandering away from the flock, the shepherd would break one of its legs to keep it home. He would nourish it back to health. The lamb would be stronger than he was before, and desire to stay close to the shepherd. Sometimes God allows something bad to happen to us to keep us on the right path. “Create in me a clean heart, O God...” Each trial you face offers you a choice: You can either grow bitter against God and walk away, or draw closer to God. Each trial you face shows that God trusted you to have the potential to pass the test. Submit yourself to the firm hand of the shepherd. Stay close to the shepherd.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a class on Leadership Development. There are five basic spiritual disciplines for leadership. (A) Church attendance, Heb. 10:25. Not attending church is a first step to backsliding. (B) Prayer and fasting, I Thess. 5:17; Eph. 6:18. Have an uninterrupted practice of prayer over matters that warrant prayer. (C) Bible reading and study, Ps. 119:111: II Tim. 3:16-17. We must be biblically literate. Read the Bible. We must store God’s word in our heart so that we can be strong when trials come. (D) Tithes and offerings, Mal. 3:8-12; II Corinth. 9:6-8. (E) Following spiritual authority, Heb. 13:17. A person who can’t bring himself under authority cannot be part of the Kingdom of God. We must set goals, for example, to pray more. Have a plan of action. This is a specific means of achieving your goal. Evaluate yourself. Re: our spiritual disciplines and physical wellbeing, we must be accountable to our family, our pastor and the collective body of the church as well.</p>
