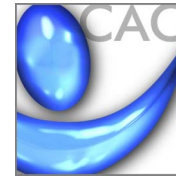

<p>Pastor Joseph taught "Relationships, Part 1: Understanding Yourself." There are two ways to look at ourselves: the Biblical way or the worldly way. We need to understand ourselves: what is wrong with us, then address it (James 1:17-25, Gen. 3:7-9, Luke 15:17, 5:31-32). We are a unique creation. We were created for God's glory. He has a unique purpose for our life. We are the object of God's love. The carnal part of us has something wrong in it, yet God's love is still unconditional. His love for us is sacrificial. We need to have a godly appreciation of the value of our soul and our worth in God's sight. We are to love ourselves and love others like we love ourselves. We need a godly understanding that through Christ we can fulfill God's will in our life. We must learn to like ourselves. Make it your goal to find purpose and meaning in your life. Fully submit yourself to God's plan. Trust God and let Him mold you into His image.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "A Burning Heart" using Luke 24: 1-5, 14-21 &amp; 30-32. When Moses had a conversation with God, he asked to see God's glory, but God replied that he couldn't see that and live. Our present bodies cannot endure the full joy of His presence. After Jesus had risen, He appeared to two disciples on the road to Emmaus. As he talked with them, they knew Him not but their hearts burned within them. After He made Himself known unto them they said "Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?" Is our heart burning within us? To be in the presence of Jesus is pure joy. It is joy unspeakable and full of glory. We must not forsake the assembling of ourselves together, but God must be in the midst. He will be with us when we get desperate and ask Him to be here. We need a prayer closet. We need to be with Jesus and keep our hearts burning. Live connected with Jesus. In Jesus is all that matters in life.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught "Relationships, Part 2: Friendship" using Prov 18:24 as his text. Aspects of the need and value of friendship include: companionship (Gen 2:18; Prov 18:24), assistance and strength (Ecc 4:9-10), counsel (Prov 27:9), mutual improvement (Proverbs 27:17), and enjoyment. We see great examples of godly friendship in the biblical accounts of David and Jonathan (I Sam 18:1-4; II Sam 1:26) and of Mary, Martha, Lazarus, and Jesus (John 11:5). In making and choosing friends: seek out friendship, be friendly to everyone, befriend those who need help and friendship, and create opportunities. But be deliberate in choosing <u>close</u> friends. Choose with prayer, seeking to avoid ungodly influences (I Cor 15:33). Do not have fellowship with hypocrites (I Cor 5:9-11). Seek compatibility of spirit and purpose, with one who is dependable, interesting, enjoyable, real, and whom you can respect. Be faithful, loyal and selfless (see Proverbs 17:17; 27:10).</p>

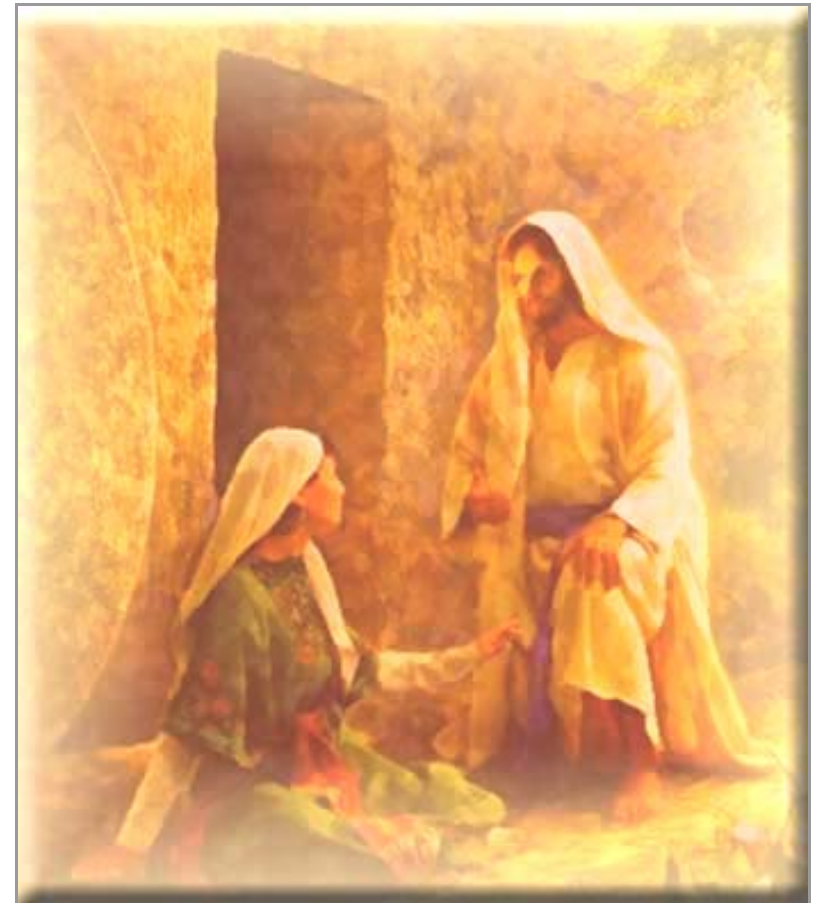
