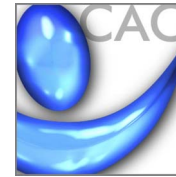

We can go to battle knowing that we will win if we have a faithful prayer life and have on the whole armor of God. We can go out with boldness and take back what the devil has stolen away from us. We shall be victorious in Christ. Praise God!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph began teaching “Relationships, Part 4: The Marriage Partnership” using Genesis 2:24 as his text. The most basic way to define marriage is that it is a <u>lifelong</u> covenant of companionship between a man and a woman, founded on this basis: leaving one’s parents, then cleaving to your wife/husband and becoming one flesh. A husband and wife must dwell together, honoring one another. If there is contention between a man and his wife their prayers may be hindered. If you aren’t right with your wife/husband, you aren’t right with God. Submit to one another in the fear of God. Marriage is a lifetime commitment. Today, grandparents and parents must teach against what the worldly, modern culture is falsely teaching our youth about marriage. They are being told to avoid marriage. They’re told crafty lies about it, including that it is not really fulfilling, it is not possible to be married for life, and even that they should seek a “soul mate” for <u>eternity</u>. Such are detrimental lies.</p>

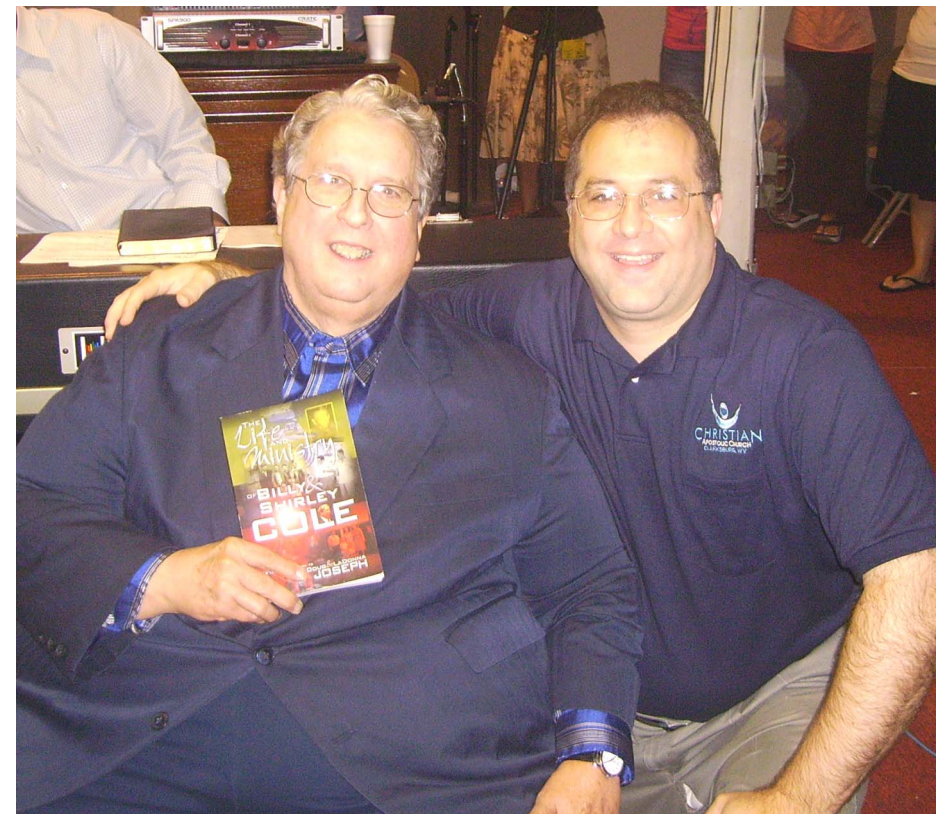
