


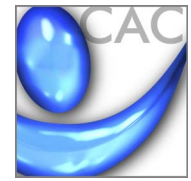
IN MEMORY OF ALL WHO HAVE SACRIFICED

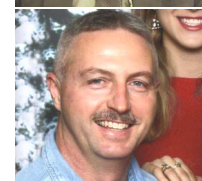
Andrew Jersey

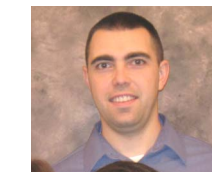
