## Pentecost Sunday (One Service Only)

Pastor Joseph preached "Importunity" using Luke 11: 5-14. In the context of this Bible passage, *importunity* refers to having boldness in asking for the infilling of the Spirit of God. If you have never received the Holy Ghost, you should focus all of your attention on Jesus Christ, and desire the gift of the Spirit more than anything. We all should focus on the outpouring of the Spirit, not only for ourselves but also in praying for others to receive. Some people claim (and some churches teach) that the Holy Ghost baptism with the evidence of speaking in tongues is not real, or that it was real long ago but no longer happens today. Neither of those statements is true. The Bible says that all who ask will receive! (See Luke 11.) A person must be filled with the Spirit to be born again for salvation. (See John 3.) The initial, physical evidence of the Holy Ghost is still speaking with tongues, just like in the Book of Acts. Through Jesus' great love and mercy He died on the cross that we may have forgiveness of sins. Salvation is free; the Holy Ghost infilling is a free gift. All we have to do is repent and ask for the Spirit. Jesus said, "And I say unto you, ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." Even though we don't deserve it, God wants us to be consistent and bold in asking for the Holy Ghost. We give good gifts unto our children; how much more will God give His Spirit to those who ask? We all need the Spirit. Without the Holy Ghost baptism, one's life and future are but a waste.

## Wednesday

Bro. Baron Claypool preached using Ezekiel 22:30 as his main text. God wants us to be mighty men. Stand up against the enemy and don't allow him to enter your territory. Don't be afraid. Listen to God and be what He wants you to be. God didn't give us the spirit of fear. Pray for your enemies. If there is an argument with your enemies, then you have lost your chance to testify and witness to them. Our neighbour isn't the problem; it's the spirit within him. Don't be entangled with the cares of this life. Stand and fight against the spirit of the world. Be mighty men of God! If anything in this world becomes more important to you than the Word of God, then get away from it. We wrestle against spirits, not flesh and blood. Go to war against the devil with prayer and fasting. We have to get to the place where we can say "No, devil, you are not tripping me up this time." God's looking for a man to make up the hedge and stand in the gap. Let that man be you. Be a mighty man for God!



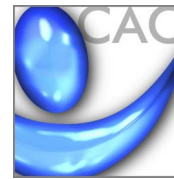
