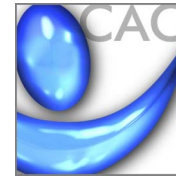

<p>Elder Lorren Godwin used I Cor. 10:3-5 as his text for teaching. We are in the Lord's army. It is our duty to be our brother's keeper by praying and helping him in any way. We should help one another when we go through things. If one of our brothers is down, he doesn't need to be kicked. Pray for him. Think of what it would be like if it were you who was down. We should treat one another with respect. Often something negative gets repeated. Don't gossip. Don't twist things to make it juicier gossip. We should be there for our brother/sister when he/she is down. The enemy is like a roaring lion seeking whom he may devour. He just springs on you. He doesn't warn us when he is going to attack. Jesus allows us to suffer attacks to make our faith stronger. We are weak, but if our faith is strong we can overcome the attacks of the devil. God's power is greater than that of Satan. Let us constantly pray, and be ever ready to protect our brother/sister in the Lord.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Keeping The Way of The Lord" using Genesis 18:19 and James 2:23. Abraham believed God, and he was called the Friend of God. It wasn't just that Abraham was so righteous. He believed God, and his faith was credited to him as righteousness. If you <i>believe</i> God you can be His friend. You should live righteously, but even then it won't <u>earn</u> God's friendship. It is a gift! Faith means that we must submit and be obedient to God as Abraham was. God knows you – your thoughts and feelings. He knows your past, present and future. True character is what you are when no one is around. God knows. He seeks men that will have children and teach them the Bible, to keep the way of the Lord. God knew Abraham would teach his children and his household to keep the way of the Lord. Thus Abraham received the promise, and became a strong nation. If we do the same, God will bless us. Fathers, train up Christian children for the Lord. It is your duty!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught "Relationships, Part 6: The Christian Parent" using Ephesians 6:4 as his main text. The role of a Christian parent is to love, nurture, admonish and train their children. They also should discipline them in love. The purpose of discipline is to instill values and modify behavior. Discipline spiritually and lovingly. Pray with and for your children at times of discipline. Inconsistent discipline is often worse than no discipline. The time to deal with a problem is when it happens. Don't allow a long time lapse between the infraction and the discipline. Don't punish your child because of a physical or mental immaturity. Do not let children discipline other children. Don't support rebellion against authority. Recognize that each and every child in a family is different. Fairness means taking that into account. Spank only on the rear, and only hard enough to cause temporary discomfort. Do not spank in public. Follow up with genuine expressions of love.</p>

II Chronicles 7:14 says,
