

Wednesday

It is crucial for a Christian to have self discipline regarding money matters. A Christian must be a good steward, faithful and wise. He must use his money as his servant and not let it become his master. Live within your means. Be willing to work hard to provide for yourself. Don't succumb to peer pressure, greed or materialism. Borrow as little as possible. "The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender" (Proverbs 22:7). Pay God first in tithes and offerings. Pay yourself next by saving some money. Trust God that He will supply your every need. Obtain insurance. Shop wisely. Budget. In making up a budget, keep a log of all your expenses for several months. Use the information in creating a budget, to aid in living within your income.

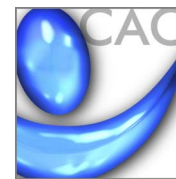
