Elder Lorren Godwin taught "If You Seek Him He Will Be Found" using I Chronicles 28:9. Put God first and all other things will follow. If you put God first it's easy to pray, come to church and do the things of God. If we let the cares of this world creep in He will cast us away. The children of today are our leaders of tomorrow. We need to teach and instruct our children in the things of God. Solomon built a great temple for God. He asked God for wisdom, but later he turned back on God. He followed after riches, women and other things that took him away from God. When we put things before God it becomes a sin. We allow so many things to come into our lives that we don't have room for God. Keep your eyes on the goal (Jesus). Seek Him and don't let anything stop you. If you seek Him, He will be found of you. But if you forsake him He will cast you off forever. Seek God first in everything! If you build a relationship with God you can't be shaken.	Pastor Joseph preached "Build On The Rock" using Matthew 7:13-29 & Rev. 19:10-16. Let Jesus reign as King of Kings and Lord of Lords in your life. When you hear God's Word, put it into practice. And then you are a wise man who is built upon the Rock. Judgement day is coming! All of the big things and the small things you've done in your lifetime will matter. The inside and the outside must be clean. If you dress holy, yet have hate and bitterness in your heart, you won't make it. God will tolerate for a long time. Just as Noah preached "Repent" for 100 years, men didn't listen and the flood came and destroyed them. One day God will say "Enough is enough" and judgement day will come. If you love holiness you are on God's side. We are to dress modestly. God has always been for holiness. If you love Jesus you will please Him. Jesus said, "My sheep listen to my voice." You must keep His Word and be built upon the rock. Have a relationship with Jesus.	Pastor Joseph taught "Growing A Church – Seven Apostolic Principles" using Acts 2:38-47. Church growth does not require that we all be special experts. It does not require some fantastic story or a new revelation—just common people willing to tell what God has done for us, and to be what God makes us. The principles for church growth are (A) Prayer: Live a life of consistent prayer. Also come before church services and spend time in prayer. (B) Persistence: Stand on truth. (C) Planning: Plan for growth, but trust God's timing. (D) Preaching and teaching of God's Word: We get what we preach. (E) Power of the Spirit: Worship God and be sensitive to the move of His Spirit. (F) Care (personal): Love and respect everyone—visitors, members, leaders. Follow up with contacts, visitors and regulars. Reach out to new converts. (G) Personal involvement – Involve everyone in service. Get an interest in a ministry-based group such as a Sunday School.



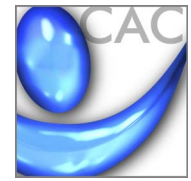
