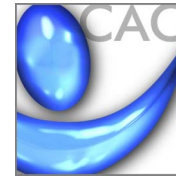

<p>Elder Charles Hoskins taught using James 1:5-8 &amp; Proverbs 2:1-5. If we ask God for wisdom, He will give it to us freely. We should ask without wavering. We should ask in faith without doubting. During the service, some of CAC's saints gave testimonies of how God has healed them. If you don't believe you're going to receive, you won't. If you have faith God will answer your prayer, you will get your answer! If you get so sick that you don't feel strong enough to pray in faith, then can ask for the prayers of the saints. God will answer their prayer. Sometimes we have to cry for God's knowledge. There are treasures in Christ. When we look back on what God has brought us through, it brings us pleasure and delights our hearts. We need to ask of God knowledge and give up whatever He asks us.
