<p>Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Revival." Vince Lombardi once said, "Practice doesn't make perfect. Perfect practice makes perfect." Reading the Bible doesn't make us perfect. But Bible study, prayer, fasting, praising, witnessing, etc. leads to perfection. Jesus never pulled any punches. He told it like it was. He always exposed a matter for just what it was. That's what we need to do—tell it like it is. Jesus never won all the people that he preached to, nor will we. But we are to preach biblical truth with love. We can only reach out to the lost by way of love. Our greatest fear should not be the coming of another 9/11 or of an assassination or of an earthquake, but rather it should be for us to have lived and wasted our life without having shared the truth of God's Word and His salvation with a lost and dying world. Have we shared God and His glory with the many lost souls around us? It is time for revival! And it must begin inside each and every one of us.</p>	<p>Elder Charles Hoskins preached "Speak Into The Darkness" using Genesis chapter 1. God is a speaking Creator. After God first made the earth, it was smooth, and it was covered with waters and therefore it was of no practical use. Darkness was upon the face of the deep. But God spoke into this darkness and brought forth the dry land, and He spoke and separated the waters, creating the heaven (sky). Everything that God spoke "was so" and still "is" unto this very day. Whenever our problems arise, we need to speak in the darkness and see that God will move. We've got His Spirit in the darkness. We need to hover around the darkness by way of the Holy Ghost. God told Abraham to sacrifice Isaac. Abraham didn't hesitate. God was testing him. He was a man of faith. He knew that God would make a way. The three Hebrew children told the king, "Our God is able to deliver us from the fiery furnace." We need to speak into the darkness. Don't let the devil control you. Speak into the darkness.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached and taught about the biblical meaning of "Calling on the Name of the Lord." Some today have mistakenly thought that calling on the Lord's name for salvation is just a verbal confession only, but the biblical record indicates much more is included. It requires obedient faith, calling upon the Lord for Him to allow us to enter into a covenant relationship with Him, and then us acting in full submission to the dictates of our covenant with Him. From the time of Seth and Enoch until Jesus, calling upon the name of the Lord included worship that involved animal sacrifice with bloodshed. That was a foreshadowing of Jesus' death on the cross for us. From the time of Christ until today, calling on the Lord's name includes obeying the gospel by following the steps laid out in John 3:3-5 and in Acts 2:38, especially the significant invoking of the Lord's name in water baptism. In any age, it is the hungry cry of those willing to submit 100% to God's plan for us.</p>



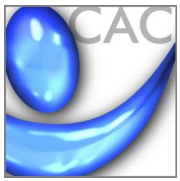

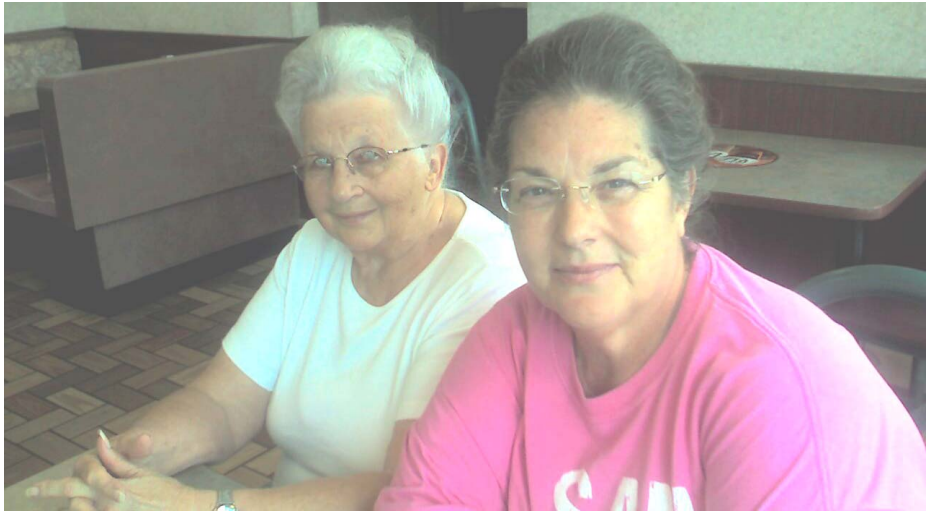
