<p>Bro. Terry Null preached using Luke 7:36-40. We cannot save ourselves from the depths of sin. We are saved by God's grace and mercy. We can stand in the presence of the almighty God. We have been identified with His name by baptism. His name, JESUS, forgives us of all our sins. There's no other name by which we can be saved. Jesus is a friend. He wanted to walk in the midst of sinners. When Jesus went to the Pharisee's house to eat, a woman came who had heard that He was going to be there. She just had to touch Jesus. She believed Jesus could change her life. Washing His feet with tears and drying them with her hair was an act of repentance. The touch of Jesus is so important in a person's life. Jesus wants people to touch Him. He knows us; He knows that we are not worthy. But we are saved by His grace. He will reach way down for us. He wants us to be identified with Him. It matters not who you are or where you've been. What matters is do you identify with Jesus!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "I Am What I Am" using I Cor. 15: 1-10 and Rev. 22:10-13. By the grace of God I am what I am. The gospel is the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ. He died on the cross and took our place. If we don't accept Him we will have to answer for our sins on Judgment Day. Sin and death are at work in our members, but God can set us free. He can help us overcome things in our lives. He wants to give us salvation. Jesus can be the ending of anything bad in your life. The best thing that could happen to anyone is Jesus. The answer to every problem we have is the gospel. We don't deserve it, but by grace Jesus gave it to us. I am what I am by the grace of God. We have a sound mind, power and love by the grace of God. We don't deserve forgiveness of sins, the Holy Ghost, or baptism in His name, but by the grace of God we have it. He didn't give us the spirit of fear but a spirit of power, love and a sound mind. I am what I am because of Jesus Christ.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached using Luke 4:1-13. Temptation strikes everyone. When we're feeling hurt or in a low state of mind, Satan strikes to draw us to temptation. The devil targets our physical desires. God is the father of Life and the devil is the father of lies. The devil uses scripture and will twist it to his liking. If we sin, we have an advocate with God, but it is better if we don't sin. Every time we sin the voice of conviction within us diminishes. The grace of God teaches us to deny ungodliness and worldly lusts. Don't use the grace of God as a license to sin. Say NO to living on the edge of sin. Stay as far away from sin as possible. Say NO to forgetfulness. Don't forget where God has brought you from. Remember to praise Him. We must resubmit our life to God. Resist the devil and temptation. Draw nigh to God. We must rebuild our life. Walk the straight and narrow way. Have a determination to overcome sin.</p>

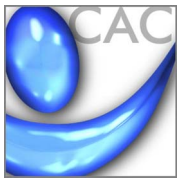
