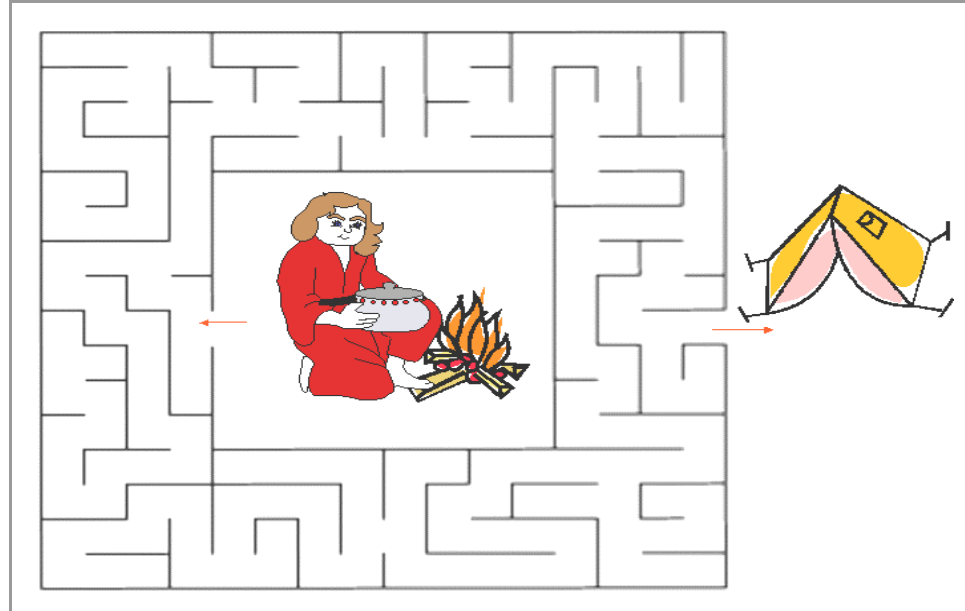

<p>Elder Lorren Godwin spoke on allowing God to use us even when others doubt us. He used II Kings 7 as his text (the story of four lepers who dared go to the enemy's camp and found it abandoned). God will use anyone if they will allow Him to. Often our fear stops us before His will is accomplished through us. David was not summoned to the ceremony to select and anoint a new king. He was not as tall or as muscular as his brothers, but his heart was right and God chose him to be king. Too often we look at our failures and our weakness and feel that we are not what God is looking for. Apostle John was placed in boiling oil to try and kill him, due to his testimony and the preaching the word of God. He survived, but was later banished to the Isle of Patmos, a prison island. Yet the Bible says he was in the Spirit on the Lord's day. That means even when things were not looking good, he still found a way to worship God. No matter the circumstance, God can find a way to use us.</p>	<p>Assistant Pastor David Harris preached "It Is Upon Me" using Isaiah 61:1-3. Jesus said (in Luke 4:18) "the Spirit of the Lord is upon me" thus fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy. We need to get to the point where the Spirit of the Lord is upon us. It must be upon us no matter where we are. The Shunammite widow had to find the prophet Elisha. She knew the Spirit of the Lord was upon him. We all need to find an elder (i.e. a pastor)—a man of God in our life—whom we desire to emulate and serve under. When Jesus walked around, people knew something was upon Him. The Holy Ghost will come upon us and give ultimate victory. We need to love one another. We need love in our marriages or they won't succeed. If you want the moving of God's Spirit, have love one to another. We need to love our pastor. He carries a load. Keep tuned into the Holy Ghost when you go about your week. His Spirit should be upon us. When was the last time you let the Spirit move upon you?</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a study of Matthew 16:18, with scholarly evidence on why it is an erroneous view to claim that Jesus built His church on Peter as a man, and that the proper interpretation is that the Rock upon which the Church is built is the revelation of who Jesus is (and what His name means), and which can only be effectual when it is granted by the Spirit of God to the heart of the believer. Grammatical and historical evidence indicates that in Matthew 16:18 Jesus actually verbalized an eloquent <i>Janus Parallelism</i>, which is a statement that hinges on the use of a single word with two different meanings, one of which forms a parallel with what precedes and the other with what follows. Thus, by virtue of a double entendre, the parallelism faces in both directions. His meaning is ultimately shown to be: "You are PETROS-Firstborn (of the divine revelation of Me) and upon this (revelation) THE PETROS (the life-giving Rock) I will build my church." (Former is Aramaic. Latter is Greek.)</p>

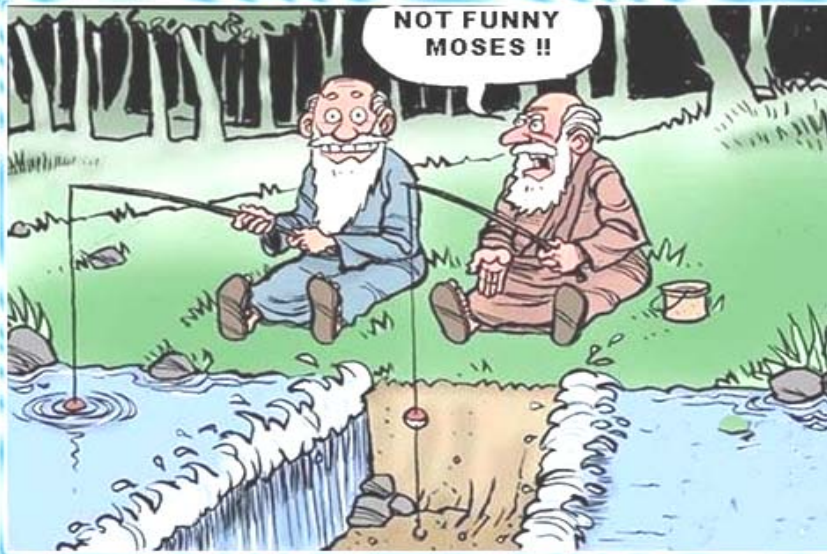

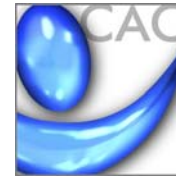
