<p>Bro. Nick Sisco, missionary to Ghana, preached "Being Real" using Matthew 16: 24-27. Many people seem to think that Christians are supposed to already be utterly perfect, and therefore many seem to live behind a "Christian" <b>mask</b>; a façade of fake perfection. On the other hand, other people err in the opposite direction. They feel that "since we cannot be perfect in any sense, we need not be worried about striving for perfection." The truth is that neither is a good place to be. Being real is trying to be more like Jesus <i>daily</i>. Don't fake perfection, but don't live as though you don't need to make daily progress toward His goal for you. What does it take to be authentic? (1) Self-denial. (2) Am I willing to carry the burden God has put on my shoulders? (3) Am I following Christ in every aspect of my life? (4) Am I ready for Jesus to return? We can follow His GPS—God's Positioning System—by obeying His Word (the Bible) and His Spirit.</p>	<p>Assistant Pastor David Harris preached "God of Ancient Times" using Isaiah 45:20-22. God wants to save, heal and set souls free. Jesus is the God of ancient times. We need Him in our midst today and to let Him walk with us and talk with us. Our God is able to do all things today as well as He did in ancient times. We serve the Almighty God. Thomas was always with Jesus and saw Him do miracles. Yet he doubted the Lord. Don't forget about the God of ancient times and put things before Him. Nothing should be more important to us than the things of God. We need to pray, fast and seek the will of God for our lives. We allow the devil to come to us. But he won't walk right into our mind unless we allow him. He will try to rock us to sleep. We need to wake up to the God of ancient times. We need to hear what the Spirit of the Lord saith to the church. People were astonished at Jesus' teaching. We need strict preaching today like in days of old.</p>	<p>Associate Pastor David Harris preached "It Is Time For a Healing" using I Corinthians 2:1-7 &amp; Acts 5:16. We need to pray, fast and get a hold of God. Many people have illnesses such as cancer, heart trouble, etc. Others have sicknesses that are caused by the weights of this world such as depression. If we get a hold to God, He is able to heal all manner of diseases. When they brought the sick and troubled people to the apostles "they were healed <u>every one</u>." The movement of God's Spirit didn't stop in the Book of Acts. We need to pray and fast and seek God. We can see sicknesses healed. We can see people set free. We need the gifts of the Spirit moving in our midst. Paul said that he didn't come with excellence of speech but in the power of God. We need to get a hold of God and see changes in situations. Prayer changes things. When you go to God in prayer things happen. It's time for a healing.</p>
