



Have on the whole armour: truth, righteousness, peace, faith and salvation. Hide God’s Word in your heart. When the devil tries to attack you, your brother can back you up.</p>	<p>Associate Pastor David Harris preached “Run In The Rain” using I Kings 18 41-46. After 3 ½ years with no rain, Elijah told Ahab that he heard the sounds of the abundance of rain. Then it rained! On the day of Pentecost there was a sound of a mighty rushing wind then God rained down His Spirit and 3,000 souls were added to the church. God is going to pour out the former and latter rain upon this earth. It’s time for the rain! It is time for us to find out what God wants. The rain of apostolic power is falling in God’s churches. The Apostolic faith is not a religion; it’s an experience. Let the spirit of God move. Some people’s experience is “I guess I’ll go to church tonight.” We need a zeal for the move of the Holy Ghost. 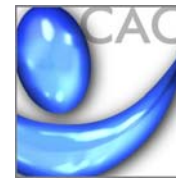
