




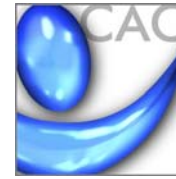

<p>Pastor Joseph taught "The Apostolic Response to Easter" using Acts 2:22-28. God gave us a freedom of choice. That includes freedom to choose wrongly! Religion is almost always an evil thing. Religion is essentially man's approach to God by MAN's WAY instead of GOD's WAY. Abel chose to worship God by blood sacrifice while Cain chose his own way. Cain's way was rejected. Will you approach God your way or His way? God's way is the redemption that comes because of the blood and death of Jesus, who died in our place on the cross (and it includes the burial and resurrection of Jesus). God's way also includes a special way for us to respond to the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. That right way is shown in Acts 2:38: We are to repent, be water baptized in Jesus' name, and be baptized with the Holy Ghost. Water baptism in Jesus' name is essential! You must be born of the water and of the Spirit. This is the Apostolic way. It's the right way!</p>	<p>Bro. Zachary Sandy preached "How Strong Is Your Hedge?" using Mark 12:1-7. We must keep our Christian ethics strong so that when the devil attacks us we'll be prepared. Also the same night, Bro. Rusty Sandy preached using Mark 5:25-34. What do we do when we see someone troubled in our midst? What is our reaction? The woman with the issue of blood had a great desire. She determined to touch the hem of Jesus' garment for her healing! She reached out and knew the power of the almighty God. Nothing is impossible with Jesus. We must "fight the good fight of faith" (see I Timothy 6:12). We must press onward to touch Jesus! Push carnal things aside and with great desire push forward to touch Jesus. When you feel like you can't make it, you must push! Let nothing stop you from touching Jesus! Just know that if you can touch Jesus, He can heal. He can take care of any problem. Stretch your faith today, and touch Him. He will work miracles for you!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on godly principles regarding finances. His title was "God of the Wallet." He used Proverbs 22:1-9 as his text. The Lord God must be the Lord of all your life, or else He is not your Lord at all. If one is not very careful, one's carnal desire for money will be a higher priority in your life than God. Ancient Jews equated wealth with godliness. That is not true. By contrast, some modern Christians equate poverty with godliness. This also is false. Wealth and godliness are not to be equated, but they are also not mutually exclusive. You can be godly while in poverty, but poverty has many disadvantages, and it can strongly encourage debt, which is generally a very bad choice and leads one into dependence on man instead of on God. Debt grants the lender power over the borrower. Christians ought to not grant to anything some power higher than God has in our lives. Tithing (giving 10% of all one's increase) and offerings (giving beyond tithes) are biblical practices of faith.</p>
