Recent Special Services

This year we had a rare double blessing; our church's 39th birthday fell on the exact same day as Pentecost Sunday (which is the annual commemoration of the initial outpouring of the Holy Ghost chronicled in the Bible in the Book of Acts, chapter 2).

We celebrated with a series of excellent revival services leading up to and including our anniversary date (which was last Sunday, May 23, 2010). Our special speaker for these services was Evangelist Mark McCool of Gulf Port, Mississippi.

Brother McCool's ministry was tremendously anointed of God, and all the messages he preached touched our hearts and helped us to break through barriers and make great strides of progress in our personal journeys with the Lord Jesus.

Friday PM - Brother McCool preached a message that stirred and strengthened faith, entitled "If God is Able, What Is Keeping You From Your Miracle?" This message brought us to place of faith that established a firm foundation for the remaining services. God built on it.

Saturday PM - Brother McCool preached on this topic: "Making Room." We need to make room in our hearts for God to do all He has promised. "All the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us" (II Corinthians 1:20). Just as Mary acknowledged a desire to receive all that the angel prophesied to her, we also need to let God know that we desire and approve of His great promises to us. This was a powerful night of affirmation!

Sunday AM - Brother McCool's message was entitled "Beyond The Blessings to The Promise." Don't settle for only the kind blessing that precedes the promise. Go all the way in God's truth! Sister Freda Anderson was wonderfully renewed in the Holy Ghost! Two CAC ministers (Bro Rusty & Elder Harris) preached at other churches and there were 3 people who were filled with the Spirit in those services!

Sunday PM - Bro. Mark McCool preached "Lord, Take Us Past the Hindrances" using Exodus 14:10-14 as his main text. During this service, Sister Jenni Claypool was marvelously renewed in the Holy Ghost, after seeking for such a renewal for 13 and a half years! *Praise the Lord!*

Pastor Joseph preached "Faith Under Attack" using I Sam. 30:1-8. We can have faith even while being attacked. David & company lost everything - wives, children, and homes.

David's men then turned against him. When we're down is no time to turn against leadership! Stay submitted to authority. David encouraged himself in God! He enquired of the Lord about what to do. Faith is to hear what God says and then get up and do it. Obey God's voice. Ezekiel obeyed God even during a vision (in which God told him to prophesy to a valley of dry bones).
