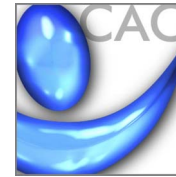

Elder Lorren God preached using Isaiah 14:12-16. We serve a great God. Consider the stars in this vast universe. God spoke each star into existence and called them by name. There are trillions of them. He knows each of us by name. And there are billions of us. His Word cannot fail. He left Heaven, a place of no pain, no tears, no troubles, and came to Earth and died on Calvary's cross for man. He chose us to serve Him. We need to praise Jesus Christ. Nothing compares to standing in the presence of Jesus Christ. He is supreme. He has all power. We have none. When we are baptized in Jesus' name we are what He is. When the devil comes against you, don't think you are helpless and can't make it. You need to stand up and, with God's help, claim victory over the devil. Worship God. Keep on the garment of praise. Bask in His glory. We have power when the devil attacks us. We aren't designed to worry. Fear not. Resist the devil—push him back—and he will flee from you. "God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind" (2 Timothy 1:7).	Associate Pastor David Harris Jr. preached "I Am Qualified" using Mark 6:1-5. Jesus went into His own country and they didn't receive Him. There was Jesus, the King, in their midst and they didn't want anything to do with Him. They were too concerned about Him being a carpenter. To be a leader, you must be a servant. We must do the works of Jesus. We are qualified. We can be witnesses for Jesus. We can invite people into the church so they can find Jesus. It doesn't take a great genius with a lot of knowledge to do something for God. It just takes someone with faith. You don't need Peter or John or a great preacher to pray for you. It just takes someone with faith to stand up and say "Be ye healed." Just believe God! We need to put God back in the place in our hearts where He ought to be. He needs to come first in our lives. We are qualified if we have repented, been baptized in Jesus' name and been filled with the Holy Ghost. It is our mission to tell others about Jesus.	Pastor Joseph preached "Finding My Place In The Kingdom" using Ephesians 4:1-13. Each one of us has a calling in God. He has given each of us "grace according to the measure of the gift of God." He knows you. Let Him do the calling and position you in your proper place in the Kingdom. There are at least four types of temperaments within people. (1) A person with a warrior temperament is thick skinned, and well suited for a prophet's calling. He should stand up for truth. (2) A person with a guardian temperament is well suited to a pastor's calling, being protective of the sheep & resistant to change. (3) A person with a healer temperament is well suited to an apostle's calling. (4) A visionary person is well suited to an evangelist's calling. Every one of us is a blend of these and other traits. We all can work together to get things done for God.

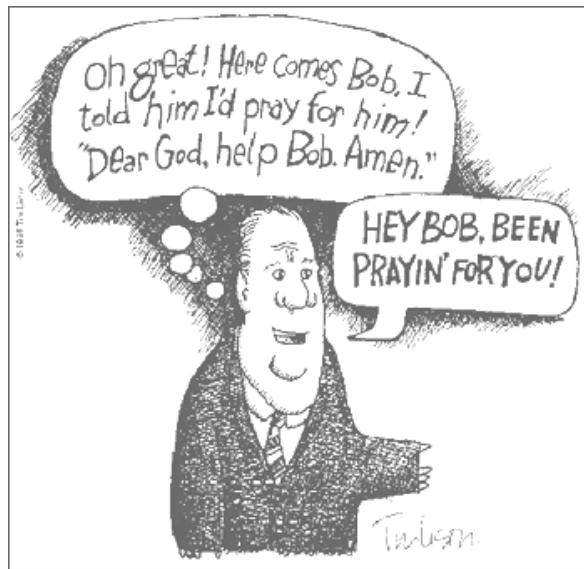
