




<p>The Terry Wilbanks Singers ministered live in concert at CAC on Sunday morning. Their anointed, exciting music is a blend of contemporary and southern gospel styles. Everyone who was present greatly enjoyed their ministry.</p>	<p>Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached a message entitled "Who is The King of Your Life?" Do you want a God that will bless you or a god who will take from you? If you serve sin and Satan, you are serving the god of this world. The Lord Jesus contrasted Satan with Himself in this way: "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep" (John 10:10-11). The Israelites cried out in slavery under the king of Egypt. The Lord heard their cry and sent Moses as a deliverer. They faced a choice of whether they wanted to serve the Pharaoh of Egypt or the God of their father Abraham. They could choose a god (power) who was robbing their lives and liberties from them, or <i>the</i> God (ultimate power) who would grant them life and liberty. Choose God!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph continued his series about the Ten Commandments, which were read from Exodus 20:1-17. The reason God gave for His people to keep the Ten Commandments was "I am the Lord, thy God." This is the same reason God gave elsewhere in association with other commandments given unto His covenant people. For example, the command (in Leviticus 19:28) for them to not cut or mark themselves was based on the same reason. (That command is one reason why Apostolics do not get tattoos once we have been converted.) Being in a covenant relationship with God is the basis for why we do our best to obey the Bible's teachings. We learn right and wrong by studying the commandments, instructions, and injunctions of wisdom in the Bible. Paul wrote that the Old Testament Law is like a schoolmaster that brings us to our Saviour, Jesus Christ (see Galatians 3:24). This night we studied the first four commandments: (1) "Thou shalt have no other gods before me." (2) "Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven images." (3) "Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain." (4) "Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy."</p>

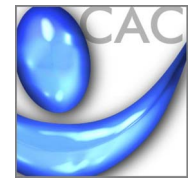
