Get excited about what God is doing and proclaim it the world.</p>	<p>Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached “Jesus Is Coming to Dinner!” For his text, he read Genesis 18:1-10, where Abraham was visited by the Lord in the form of a theophany (an angel speaking on behalf of God) and by two other angels. Abraham quickly set about preparing a feast for his heavenly guests. While the Lord visited him, God told Abraham two amazing things. One was that Abraham and Sarah were going to have a baby boy, even though they were both old and well stricken in years (past child bearing age). That promise was fulfilled at the appointed time the following year. The other was that Sodom and Gomorrah would be destroyed, which was fulfilled soon after the visit. Elder Harris also read from Mark 8:2-9 and John 6:5-12. Both passages are about when the Lord multiplied food and fed thousands. He also read from Luke 19:2-6, where the Lord told Zacchaeus He would have dinner with him. The Lord brought blessings and repentance to Zacchaeus. Whenever Jesus comes to dinner great things will happen!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Be Changed” using Romans 12:1-2. We need to have an ongoing relationship with Jesus Christ. Pray, fast, study God’s Word, and be faithful to the church services. Because although we’ve been transformed, our carnal frame continually works against our spirit. So we need to walk as deep in God and His Word as we can. We need God, and we need each other. Be faithful to church. Be faithful to prayer. Sometimes our thinking gets turned wrong. We need to renew our minds to transform our thinking. If we have doubt we will act according to our bad thoughts. Everywhere we go people should be healed and/or saved. Let’s turn this town upside down!</p>

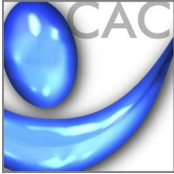

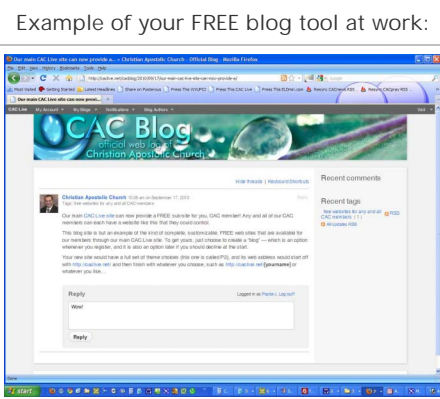
