Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached using Luke 10:2-3 as his text. God has called us out from the worldly culture to be a separate people. We ought to hate sin while loving the sinner. This requires that we speak the truth in love. We can and must teach sinners right from wrong while doing our best to not treat them harshly or with meanness. When Moses came down from the mountain and found the Israelites committing all manner of sins while they worshipped a golden calf, his wrath caused him to smash and break the stone tablets that displayed the Ten Commandments. Yet his anger did not cause the people to become righteous. The tablets had to be remade, and he later had to finally deliver the message of what God commands. "The wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God" (James 1:20). God hates sin but He loves sinners. Even when He finally has to judge them in the end, He will still love them. It is essential for the church to teach God's law. We must warn people about worldly American culture. When one violates God's law, he actually breaks himself. Someone who pleases worldly culture rather than pleasing God is very unwise. Let the world know that you love them and God loves them. Instruct them with love and compassion, not with wrath and anger.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Powerful Hand of God" using Acts 1:4-8 and Luke 10:17-20 & 23-25. All creation resulted directly from the hand of God. He is omnipotent, having no equal. God chose from the beginning to create us as free moral agents, able to choose right or wrong. God does not force people to serve Him. He gave humanity freewill to choose life or death. Because the first man, Adam, sold humanity as slaves to sin, we were all born with the sin curse. Jesus died on the cross to take away that sin curse. Although God is all powerful, He allows people to have certain powers, whether *exousia* (authority type power) or *dunamis* (ability type power). If we abuse or misuse either one, God can take away our authority and/or grant someone else authority that overrules our abilities. Let us rejoice not because demon spirits are subject unto us, but because our names are written in the Lamb's Book of Life. Simon the sorcerer wanted to buy with money the authority to give people Holy Ghost. Peter rebuked him, showing that this authority cannot be bought with money. It is the gift of God to those whose heart is right with God.

Elder David Harris Jr. preached "Mighty Men" using I John 4:4. God's Spirit is moving everywhere. He wants us to be mighty and bold. Be mighty in prayer. Be mighty in fasting. Nothing can stop us when we are mighty men. Though we walk in this flesh, we do not war after the flesh. We must put on the *whole* armor of God. Cast down imaginations and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God. Bring into captivity every thought to the obedience of God. We can be mighty through God to pull down strongholds. When you work for God something always tries to distract you. Be mighty! Be strong in the Lord. We are going to win this battle.
