Last Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin spoke on having a passion for Jesus Christ. To have a passion for Jesus means you will do everything you can to bond with Him. We must serve Him with love and dedication. Job was a man with passion for God. He was a “perfect” man (meaning mature to the point of being pleasing to God) who put God first in all he did. We must continually sacrifice and seek God’s face as Job did. “Seek ye first the kingdom of God” (Matthew 6:33). Keep God first in all you do. Have no other gods before Jesus Christ. Idols can include your family, friends, job, car, possessions —anything that you let come between you and God. Job’s wife and friends turned their backs on him, but he had love and passion for God. He still had his relationship with God. He said, “Blessed be the name of the Lord.” Jesus laid His life down on the cross so we could have a relationship with Him. Do we come to church because it’s Sunday or Wednesday night? Or do we come because we want to please Him, to keep our relationship with Him and to give praise and worship to Him? We must continually desire to become more like Jesus. Be determined that you are going to serve God.

Sunday PM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached from Acts 2:3. On the day of Pentecost “they were all with one accord in one place.” They received the promise of the Holy Ghost. This is what people are searching for. When people bind together in Jesus name then God moves. We don’t have to sing for an hour and a half to get God to move. Just yield to the Spirit of God. Jesus was asleep in a boat when a great tempest arose in the sea. His disciples awoke Him saying, Lord, save us. He rebuked the wind and there was a great calm. There was a man who had devils, and no man could tame him. He wore no clothes and dwelled in tombs. But when he saw Jesus, he fell down and worshipped him. Jesus cast the devils out of him into pigs. This is the power of God. You can’t argue with a person about what God has done for him. We need to bind together and seek His face. Then God will add to the church. Jesus can change your life today as He changed lives back then. This is Apostolic fire!

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught “The Everlasting Covenant.” The Book of Hebrews refers at least 17 times to the atoning death of Christ, but Hebrews 13:20 (at the climax near the end of the book) is the only verse in Hebrews that *specifically* refers to Christ’s resurrection from the dead. The death of Jesus and His shed blood are always associated with God’s everlasting covenant with His people. The covenant theme is strong in the book of Hebrews. The Greek word *diatheke* (covenant), which is also frequently translated “testament”, occurs more in Hebrews than in all the rest of the New Testament (or “New Covenant”) put together. The word basically means a contract, especially one for disposition of an inheritance. The Bible tells of several divine covenants, but Hebrews focuses on the new covenant. It is surely the most significant of all covenants. This new covenant is also called

“a better covenant” (Hebrews 7:22; 8:6). It is best defined in Hebrews 8:10-12, quoting Jeremiah 31:33-34: “I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts:...and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.” Jesus is “the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of **eternal inheritance**” (Hebrews 9:15). The inheritance is eternal because the covenant is everlasting. The blood of the covenant is the infinitely precious blood of Christ, whom God has raised from the dead, and now “he ever liveth to make intercession” for all those who “come unto God by him” (Hebrews 7:25).

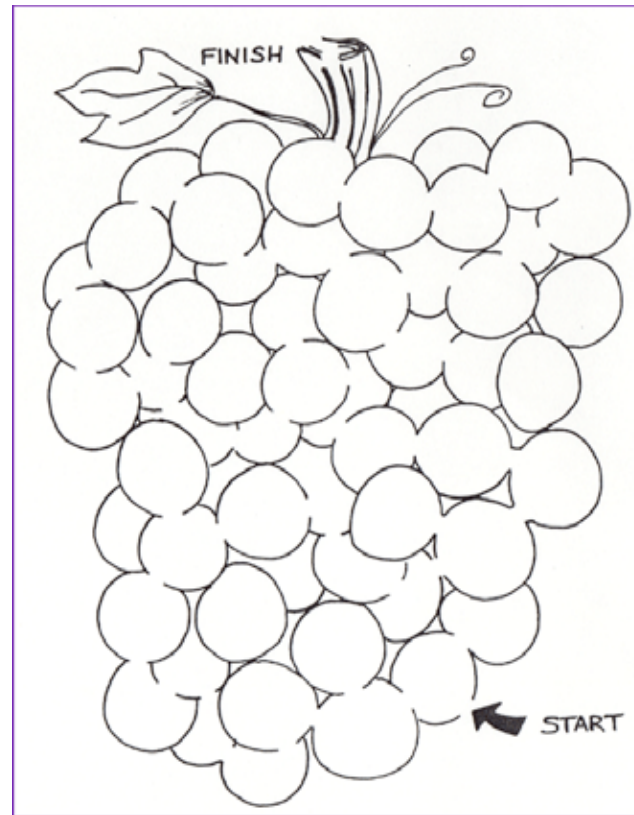

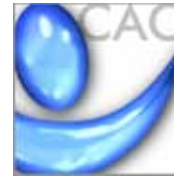
